AN ACT relating to traffic laws; extending from semiannual to annual the interval at which records of traffic citations must be audited by governmental agencies; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law requires a fiscal officer of a governmental agency to which a
2 traffic enforcement agency is responsible to audit semiannually every record of
3 traffic citations issued by the traffic enforcement agency. (NRS 484A.690) This bill
4 revises that provision to require annual audits instead of semiannual audits.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 484A.690 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:
3 484A.690 Every record of traffic citations required in chapters
4 484A to 484E, inclusive, of NRS **[shall] must** be audited at least
5 **[semiannually]** **annually** by the appropriate fiscal officer of the
6 governmental agency to which the traffic enforcement agency is
7 responsible.
