BROOKS; ANDERSON AND DIAZ

SUMMARY—Provides a classification of licensing for certain persons who install and maintain thermal system insulation. (BDR 54-1080)

AN ACT relating to contractors; requiring the State Contractors' Board to establish an advisory committee relating to the classification of licensing for certain persons who install and maintain building shell insulation or thermal system insulation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Under existing law, the State Contractors' Board is authorized to establish
2 advisory committees in topical areas, as the Board deems necessary. (NRS
3 624.100) **Section 2** of this bill requires that Board to establish an advisory
4 committee to make recommendations concerning persons who install and maintain
5 building shell insulation or thermal system insulation.
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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** (Deleted by amendment.)
2 **Sec. 2.** NRS 624.100 is hereby amended to read as follows:
3 624.100 1. The Board may appoint such committees and
4 make such reasonable bylaws, rules of procedure and regulations as
5 are necessary to carry out the provisions of this chapter.
6 2. ~~The~~ *Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, the*
7 Board may establish advisory committees composed of its members
8 or employees, homeowners, contractors or other qualified persons to



1 provide assistance with respect to fraud in construction, or in any
2 other area that the Board considers necessary.

3 3. *The Board shall establish an advisory committee to make*
4 *recommendations to the Board concerning the classification of*
5 *licensure of persons who install or maintain building shell*
6 *insulation or thermal system insulation, including, without*
7 *limitation, recommendations relating to training and continuing*
8 *education.*

9 4. If ~~{the Board establishes}~~ an advisory committee ~~{}~~ *is*
10 *established*, the Board shall:

11 (a) Select five members for the committee from a list of
12 volunteers approved by the Board; and

13 (b) Adopt rules of procedure for informal conferences of the
14 committee.

15 ~~{4.}~~ 5. If ~~{the Board establishes}~~ an advisory committee ~~{}~~ *is*
16 *established*, the members:

17 (a) Serve at the pleasure of the Board.

18 (b) Serve without compensation, but must be reimbursed for
19 travel expenses necessarily incurred in the performance of their
20 duties. The rate must not exceed the rate provided for state officers
21 and employees generally.

22 (c) Shall provide a written summary report to the Board, within
23 15 days after the final informal conference of the committee, that
24 includes recommendations with respect to actions that are necessary
25 to reduce and prevent the occurrence of fraud in construction, or on
26 such other issues as requested by the Board.

27 ~~{5.}~~ 6. The Board is not bound by any recommendation made
28 by an advisory committee.

29 7. *As used in this section:*

30 (a) *“Building shell insulation” means a product that is used as*
31 *part of the building which insulates a boundary between indoor*
32 *and outdoor space or conditioned and unconditioned space,*
33 *including, without limitation, walls, ceilings or floors.*

34 (b) *“Thermal system insulation” means a product that is used*
35 *in a heating, ventilating, cooling, plumbing or refrigeration system*
36 *to insulate any hot or cold surface, including, without limitation, a*
37 *pipe, duct, valve, boiler, flue or tank, or equipment on or in a*
38 *building.*
