

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 481—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety to replace certain fleet vehicles. (BDR S-1250)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public Safety to replace certain fleet vehicles; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 Highway Fund to the Nevada Highway Patrol Division of the
3 Department of Public Safety the sum of \$5,331,325 to replace fleet
4 vehicles which have exceeded the 105,000 mile threshold for sedans
5 and the 125,000 mile threshold for trucks and sports utility vehicles.

6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
7 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
8 June 30, 2013, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
9 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
10 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
11 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
12 after September 20, 2013, by either the entity to which the money
13 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
14 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway
15 Fund on or before September 20, 2013.



1 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
