

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 495—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Division of Forestry of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for necessary services and equipment to transition the State's Very High Frequency radio system from wideband to narrowband in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission mandate. (BDR S-1247)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Division of Forestry of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for necessary services and equipment to transition the State's Very High Frequency radio system from wideband to narrowband in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission mandate; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
- 2 General Fund to the Division of Forestry of the State Department of
- 3 Conservation and Natural Resources the sum of \$162,267 for
- 4 necessary services and equipment to transition the State's Very High
- 5 Frequency radio system from wideband to narrowband in
- 6 accordance with the Federal Communications Commission
- 7 mandate.

1 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
2 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
3 June 30, 2013, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
4 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
5 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
6 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
7 after September 20, 2013, by either the entity to which the money
8 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
9 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State General
10 Fund on or before September 20, 2013.

11 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
