

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 498—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

(ON BEHALF OF THE DIVISION OF BUDGET AND PLANNING)

SUMMARY—Suspends temporarily the requirement for the administration of norm-referenced examinations in public schools. (BDR 34-1174)

AN ACT relating to education; suspending temporarily the requirement for the administration of norm-referenced examinations in public schools; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law requires the board of trustees of each school district and the
2 governing body of each charter school to administer norm-referenced examinations
3 in grades 4, 7 and 10 which compare the results of pupils enrolled in those grades in
4 public schools in this State to a national reference group of pupils. (NRS 389.015)
5 Senate Bill No. 416 of the 2009 Legislative Session suspended temporarily the
6 administration of the norm-referenced examinations for the 2009-2011 biennium.
7 (Chapter 423, Statutes of Nevada 2009, p. 2340) This bill again suspends
8 temporarily the administration of the norm-referenced examinations for the 2011-
9 2013 biennium.

2 **Sec. 7.5.** Notwithstanding the provisions of NRS 389.015 to
3 the contrary, the norm-referenced examinations required to be
4 administered to pupils enrolled in grades 4, 7 and 10 pursuant to that
5 section must not be administered in the public schools of this State
6 during the 2011-2012 school year and the 2012-2013 school year.
7 Any requirements relating to the reporting of test scores of pupils on
8 those examinations that would otherwise be administered during
9 those school years are also suspended.

10 **Sec. 8.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
