

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 515—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

(ON BEHALF OF THE DIVISION OF BUDGET AND PLANNING)

MARCH 28, 2011

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Revises certain provisions governing the Nevada Junior Livestock Show Board. (BDR 50-1208)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in *bolded italics* is new; matter between brackets ~~omitted material~~ is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to the promotion of livestock; making various changes to the Nevada Junior Livestock Show Board; repealing the requirement that the promotion of livestock be funded by direct legislative appropriation from the State General Fund; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

- 1 Under existing law, members of the Nevada Junior Livestock Show Board are
- 2 entitled to receive compensation, per diem allowances and travel expenses provided
- 3 for state officers and employees generally. (NRS 563.060) **Section 7** of this bill
- 4 repeals that provision, and **section 3** of this bill prohibits members of the Board
- 5 from receiving compensation, per diem allowances and travel expenses.
- 6 Under existing law, one of the members of the Board must be a member of the
- 7 staff of the State Board for Career and Technical Education. (NRS 563.030)
- 8 **Section 4** of this bill replaces that member with a person who is a secondary
- 9 agriculture educator nominated by the agriculture education program professional
- 10 at the Department of Education.
- 11 Existing law requires the Board to maintain possession and care of all property
- 12 of the Nevada Junior Livestock Show, the Nevada Youth Livestock and Dairy
- 13 Show and the Nevada State Horse Program and each year to conduct the Nevada
- 14 Junior Livestock Show, the Nevada Youth Livestock and Dairy Show and the
- 15 Nevada State Horse Program. (NRS 563.080, 563.100) **Sections 5 and 6** of this bill
- 16 delete the Nevada State Horse Program from those requirements.



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** (Deleted by amendment.)

2 **Sec. 2.** (Deleted by amendment.)

3 **Sec. 3.** Chapter 563 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
4 thereto a new section to read as follows:

5 *The members of the Board serve without compensation and are*
6 *not entitled to the per diem and travel expenses provided for state*
7 *officers and employees generally.*

8 **Sec. 4.** NRS 563.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 563.030 1. One member of the Board must be a member of
10 the teaching staff of the College of Agriculture, *Biotechnology and*
11 *Natural Resources* of the University of Nevada, Reno.

12 2. One member of the Board must be a member of the staff of
13 the ~~[Agricultural Extension Department of the Public Service~~
14 ~~Division of the Nevada System of Higher Education.]~~ *University of*
15 *Nevada Cooperative Extension.*

16 3. One member of the Board must be a ~~[member of the staff of~~
17 ~~the State Board for Career and Technical Education.]~~ *secondary*
18 *agriculture educator nominated by the agriculture education*
19 *program professional at the Department of Education.*

20 4. Four members of the Board must be persons concerned with
21 the raising and improving of livestock in the State of Nevada, not
22 necessarily stock raisers, selected as follows:

23 (a) Two persons whose interest is in cattle and sheep;

24 (b) One person whose interest is in ~~[horses;]~~ *general*
25 *agriculture;* and

26 (c) One person whose interest is in dairying.

27 5. All members must be residents of the State of Nevada.

28 **Sec. 5.** NRS 563.080 is hereby amended to read as follows:

29 563.080 1. The Board shall have possession and care of all
30 property of the Nevada Junior Livestock Show ~~[.]~~ *and* the Nevada
31 Youth Livestock and Dairy Show ~~[and the Nevada State Horse~~
32 ~~Program]~~ and shall be entrusted with the direction of the entire
33 business and financial affairs of these exhibitions.

34 2. The Board ~~[shall have the power:]~~ *may:*

35 (a) ~~[To appoint]~~ *Appoint* employees and define their duties.

36 (b) ~~[To adopt]~~ *Adopt* bylaws, rules and regulations for the
37 government of the Nevada Junior Livestock Show Board, the
38 *Nevada* Junior Livestock Show ~~[.]~~ *and* the Nevada Youth Livestock
39 and Dairy Show ~~[, the Nevada State Horse Program,]~~ and for all
40 exhibitions of livestock.

41 (c) ~~[To acquire]~~ *Acquire* or lease real and personal property,
42 buildings and improvements.



1 **Sec. 6.** NRS 563.100 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 563.100 1. The Nevada Junior Livestock Show Board shall
3 each year conduct the *Nevada* Junior Livestock Show ~~{ }~~ *and* the
4 Nevada Youth Livestock and Dairy Show ~~{and the Nevada State~~
5 ~~Horse Program}~~ at places to be determined by the Board.

6 2. To enter any exhibition named in subsection 1, a person
7 must : ~~{be:}~~

8 (a) ~~{Certified}~~ *Be certified* by the State 4-H Club Leader or the
9 ~~{State Supervisor of Occupational Agricultural}~~ *agriculture*
10 *education program professional at the Department of* Education;
11 and

12 (b) ~~{Under}~~ *Be under* 19 years of age except that the Board,
13 upon considering the requirements of a specific event involved may
14 allow entry by a person 19 years of age or older who is registered as
15 a regular student in an animal science course under the Nevada
16 System of Higher Education.

17 3. Entries of animals in any exhibition named in subsection 1
18 are limited to those owned or controlled according to the
19 requirements of the exhibition.

20 **Sec. 7.** NRS 563.060 and 563.140 are hereby repealed.

21 **Sec. 8.** Any remaining balance of an appropriation made
22 pursuant to NRS 563.140 must not be committed for expenditure
23 after June 30, 2011, and reverts to the State General Fund as soon as
24 all payments of money committed have been made.

25 **Sec. 9.** Notwithstanding the amendatory provisions of this act,
26 the member of the Nevada Junior Livestock Show Board who is a
27 member of the staff of the Agricultural Extension Department of the
28 Public Service Division of the Nevada System of Higher Education
29 pursuant to subsection 2 of NRS 563.030 and the member of that
30 Board who is a member of the staff of the State Board for Career
31 and Technical Education appointed pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS
32 563.030 on July 1, 2011, and who are otherwise qualified to serve as
33 members of that Board on that date may continue to serve for the
34 remainder of their respective unexpired terms or until their
35 respective successors are appointed pursuant to subsections 2 and 3
36 of NRS 563.030, as amended by section 4 of this act, whichever
37 occurs first.

38 **Sec. 10.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2011.



TEXT OF REPEALED SECTIONS

563.060 Compensation of members and employees.

1. The members of the Board are entitled to receive a salary of not more than \$80, as fixed by the Board, for each day's attendance at a meeting of the Board.

2. While engaged in the business of the Board, each member and employee of the Board is entitled to receive the per diem allowance and travel expenses provided for state officers and employees generally.

563.140 Legislative appropriations. Funds to carry out the provisions of this chapter shall be provided by direct legislative appropriation from the General Fund, upon the presentation of budgets in the manner required by law, and shall be paid out on claims as other claims against the State are paid.

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
