
ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 525—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS**(ON BEHALF OF THE DIVISION OF BUDGET AND PLANNING)****MARCH 28, 2011**

Referred to Committee on Ways and Means**SUMMARY**—Requires the establishment of the Wildlife Trust Fund. (BDR 45-1213)**FISCAL NOTE:** Effect on Local Government: No.

AN ACT relating to wildlife; requiring the Department of Wildlife to establish the Wildlife Trust Fund; authorizing the Department to accept any gift, donation, bequest or devise from any private source for the Wildlife Trust Fund; requiring the Director to report income and expenditures from the Wildlife Trust Fund to the Chief of the Budget Division of the Department of Administration, the Interim Finance Committee and the Board of Wildlife Commissioners; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

This bill requires the Department of Wildlife to establish the Wildlife Trust Fund for the purposes of receiving any gift, donation, bequest or devise from any private source for the Wildlife Trust Fund. The money in the Wildlife Trust Fund must be used either for the specified purpose of the donor who donated the money or, if the donor specified no purpose, then in the sound discretion of the Director of the Department. This bill further establishes that the money in the Wildlife Trust Fund is private money and exempts the expenditure of money in the Wildlife Trust Fund from the provisions of the State Purchasing Act. Finally, this bill requires the Director to report the income and expenditures of the Wildlife Trust Fund to the Chief of the Budget Division of the Department of Administration, the Interim Finance Committee and the Board of Wildlife Commissioners.



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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 501 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *1. The Department shall establish the Wildlife Trust Fund.
4 The Department may accept any gift, donation, bequest or devise
5 from any private source for deposit in the Wildlife Trust Fund.
6 Any money received is private money and not state money. All
7 money must be accounted for in the Wildlife Trust Fund.*

8 *2. All of the money in the Wildlife Trust Fund must be
9 deposited in a financial institution to draw interest or to be
10 expended, invested and reinvested pursuant to the specific
11 instructions of the donor, or if no such specific instructions exist,
12 in the sound discretion of the Director. The provisions of NRS
13 356.011 apply to any accounts in financial institutions maintained
14 pursuant to this section.*

15 *3. The money in the Wildlife Trust Fund must be budgeted
16 and expended, within any limitations which may have been
17 specified by particular donors, at the discretion of the Director.
18 The Director may authorize independent contractors that may be
19 funded in whole or in part from the money in the Wildlife Trust
20 Fund.*

21 *4. The Director or the Director's designee shall submit
22 semiannually to the Interim Finance Committee and the
23 Commission a report concerning the investment and expenditure
24 of the money in the Wildlife Trust Fund in such form and detail as
25 the Interim Finance Committee determines is necessary.*

26 *5. A separate statement concerning the anticipated amount
27 and proposed expenditures of the money in the Wildlife Trust
28 Fund must be submitted to the Chief of the Budget Division of the
29 Department of Administration for his or her information at the
30 same time and for the same fiscal years as the requested budget of
31 the Department submitted pursuant to NRS 353.210. The
32 statement must be attached to the requested budget for the
33 Department when the requested budget is submitted to the Fiscal
34 Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to
35 NRS 353.211.*

36 *6. The provisions of chapter 333 of NRS do not apply to the
37 expenditure of money in the Wildlife Trust Fund.*

38 **Sec. 2.** NRS 501.356 is hereby amended to read as follows:

39 501.356 1. Money received by the Department from:

40 (a) The sale of licenses;

41 (b) Fees pursuant to the provisions of NRS 488.075
42 and 488.1795;



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1 (c) Remittances from the State Treasurer pursuant to the
2 provisions of NRS 365.535;

3 (d) Appropriations made by the Legislature; and

4 (e) All other sources, except money derived from the forfeiture
5 of any property described in NRS 501.3857 or money deposited in
6 the Wildlife Heritage Trust Account pursuant to NRS 501.3575 ,
7 ~~for~~ in the Trout Management Account pursuant to NRS 502.327 ~~for~~
8 *or in the Wildlife Trust Fund pursuant to section 1 of this act,*
9 → must be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the
10 Wildlife Account in the State General Fund.

11 2. The interest and income earned on the money in the Wildlife
12 Account, after deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to
13 the Account.

14 3. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4, the
15 Department may use money in the Wildlife Account only to carry
16 out the provisions of this title and chapter 488 of NRS and as
17 provided in NRS 365.535, and the money must not be diverted to
18 any other use.

19 4. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 502.250 and 504.155,
20 all fees for the sale or issuance of stamps, tags, permits and licenses
21 that are required to be deposited in the Wildlife Account pursuant to
22 the provisions of this title and any matching money received by the
23 Department from any source must be accounted for separately and
24 must be used:

25 (a) Only for the management of wildlife; and

26 (b) If the fee is for the sale or issuance of a license, permit or tag
27 other than a tag specified in subsection 5 or 6 of NRS 502.250,
28 under the guidance of the Commission pursuant to subsection 2 of
29 NRS 501.181.

30 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2011.
