**SUMMARY**—Revises provisions concerning reinstatement of insurance under the Public Employees' Benefits Program. (BDR 23-497)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to the Public Employees' Benefits Program; revising provisions concerning reinstatement of insurance under the Program; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Under existing law, a retired public officer or employee of the State or a local government, or his or her surviving spouse, who has cancelled insurance provided under the Public Employees' Benefits Program is authorized to reinstate such insurance, other than life insurance, during the so-called late enrollment period, which occurs in each even-numbered year. (NRS 287.0205, 287.0475) **Sections 1 and 3** of this bill eliminate the right of biennial reinstatement for insurance provided under the Program. However, **section 3**, with certain exceptions, authorizes a retired public officer or employee of the State or a participating local government, or his or her surviving spouse, to reinstate insurance if the retired public officer or employee did not have more than one period during which he or she was not covered under the Program on or after October 1, 2011, or on or after the date of his or her retirement, whichever is later. **Section 3** also prohibits a public officer or employee who retired from a local governmental agency, or his or her surviving spouse, from reinstating health insurance under the Program if the Board of the Program has adopted regulations that exclude such persons from participation in the Program because they are eligible for health coverage from a health and welfare plan or trust that arose out of certain collective bargaining agreements or under certain federal laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** NRS 287.0205 is hereby amended to read as  
2 follows:

3       287.0205 1. A public officer or employee of any county,  
4 school district, municipal corporation, political subdivision, public  
5 corporation or other local governmental agency of the State of  
6 Nevada who has retired pursuant to NRS 1A.350 or 1A.480, or  
7 286.510 or 286.620, or is enrolled in a retirement program provided  
8 pursuant to NRS 286.802, or the surviving spouse of such a retired  
9 public officer or employee who is deceased, may, *except as*  
10 *otherwise provided in NRS 287.0475*, in any even-numbered year,  
11 reinstate any insurance, except life insurance, that, at the time of  
12 reinstatement, is provided by the last public employer of the retired  
13 public officer or employee to the active officers and employees and  
14 their dependents of that public employer:

15      (a) Pursuant to NRS 287.010, 287.015, 287.020 or paragraph  
16 (b), (c) or (d) of subsection 1 of NRS 287.025; or

17      (b) Under the Public Employees' Benefits Program, if the last  
18 public employer of the retired officer or employee participates in the  
19 Public Employees' Benefits Program pursuant to paragraph (a) of  
20 subsection 1 of NRS 287.025.

21      2. Reinstatement pursuant to paragraph (a) of subsection 1  
22 must be requested by:

23      (a) Giving written notice of the intent of the public officer or  
24 employee or surviving spouse to reinstate the insurance to the last  
25 public employer of the public officer or employee not later than  
26 January 31 of an even-numbered year;

27      (b) Accepting the public employer's current program or plan of  
28 insurance and any subsequent changes thereto; and

29      (c) Except as otherwise provided in subparagraph (2) of  
30 paragraph (b) of subsection 4 of NRS 287.023, paying any portion  
31 of the premiums or contributions of the public employer's program  
32 or plan of insurance, in the manner set forth in NRS 1A.470 or  
33 286.615, which is due from the date of reinstatement and not paid  
34 by the public employer.

35      → The last public employer shall give the insurer notice of the  
36 reinstatement not later than March 31 of the year in which the public  
37 officer or employee or surviving spouse gives notice of the intent to  
38 reinstate the insurance.

39      3. Reinstatement pursuant to paragraph (b) of subsection 1  
40 must be requested pursuant to NRS 287.0475.

41      4. Reinstatement of insurance pursuant to subsection 1  
42 excludes claims for expenses for any condition for which medical



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1 advice, treatment or consultation was rendered within 12 months  
2 before reinstatement unless the reinstated insurance has been in  
3 effect more than 12 consecutive months.

4       5. The last public employer of a retired officer or employee  
5 who reinstates insurance, except life insurance, which was provided  
6 to the retired officer or employee and the retired officer's or  
7 employee's dependents at the time of retirement pursuant to NRS  
8 287.010, 287.015, 287.020 or paragraph (b), (c) or (d) of subsection  
9 1 of NRS 287.025 shall, for the purpose of establishing actuarial  
10 data to determine rates and coverage for such persons, commingle  
11 the claims experience of such persons with the claims experience of  
12 active and retired officers and employees and their dependents who  
13 participate in that group insurance, plan of benefits or medical and  
14 hospital service.

16     **Sec. 3.** NRS 287.0475 is hereby amended to read as follows:

17     287.0475 1. **[A] Except as otherwise provided in subsection**  
18 **4,** **a** retired public officer or employee or the surviving spouse of a  
19 retired public officer or employee who is deceased may **[, in any**  
20 **even numbered year,]** reinstate any insurance under the Program,  
21 except life insurance, that, at the time of reinstatement, is provided  
22 by the Program if the retired public officer or employee :**[retired.]**

23     (a) **Retired:**

24       (b) Pursuant to NRS 1A.350 or 1A.480, or 286.510 or  
25 286.620, from a participating state agency or was enrolled in a  
26 retirement program provided pursuant to NRS 286.802; or

27       (c) Pursuant to NRS 1A.350 or 1A.480, or 286.510 or  
28 286.620, from employment with a county, school district, municipal  
29 corporation, political subdivision, public corporation or other local  
30 governmental agency of the State which is a participating local  
31 governmental agency at the time of the request for reinstatement **[,]**  
32 ; and

33       (d) **Did not have more than one period during which the**  
34 **retired public officer or employee was not covered by insurance**  
35 **under the Program on or after October 1, 2011, or on or after the**  
36 **date of retirement of the public officer or employee, whichever is**  
37 **later.**

38     2. Reinstatement pursuant to subsection 1 must be requested  
39 by:

40       (a) Giving written notice to the Program of the intent of the  
41 public officer or employee or surviving spouse to reinstate the  
42 insurance not later than **[March 15 of an even numbered]** **31 days**  
43 **before the commencement of the plan** year;

44       (b) Accepting the Program's current plan of insurance and any  
45 subsequent changes thereto; and



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1       (c) Except as otherwise provided in NRS 287.046, paying any  
2 portion of the premiums or contributions for coverage under the  
3 Program, in the manner set forth in NRS 1A.470 or 286.615, which  
4 are due from the date of reinstatement and not paid by the public  
5 employer.

6       3. Reinstatement of insurance excludes claims for expenses for  
7 any condition for which medical advice, treatment or consultation  
8 was rendered within 12 months before reinstatement unless the  
9 reinstated insurance has been in effect more than 12 consecutive  
10 months.

11      *4. If a retired public officer or employee retired pursuant to  
12 NRS 1A.350 or IA.480, or 286.510 or 286.620, from employment  
13 with a county, school district, municipal corporation, political  
14 subdivision, public corporation or other local governmental  
15 agency, the retired public officer or employee, or the surviving  
16 spouse of such a retired public officer or employee who is  
17 deceased, may not reinstate health insurance pursuant to  
18 subsection 1 if he or she is excluded from participation in the  
19 Program pursuant to sub subparagraph (III) of subparagraph (2)  
20 of paragraph (h) of subsection 2 of NRS 287.043.*
