Marcia de Braga to the Assembly Wall of Distinction.

1 WHEREAS, The Assembly of the Legislature of the State of
2 Nevada has established an Assembly Wall of Distinction for those
3 past members selected by leadership who served with great
4 distinction and who made exemplary contributions to the State of
5 Nevada; and

6 WHEREAS, The members of the Nevada Legislature are
7 saddened by the loss of one of their own, former Assemblyman
8 Marcia de Braga; and

9 WHEREAS, Marcia de Braga served Nevada and the constituents
10 of Assembly District 35 with unwavering integrity, courage, and
11 good humor for five regular and two special legislative sessions; and

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. de Braga was instrumental in securing funding
13 to study the causes of Fallon’s deadly leukemia cluster; and

14 WHEREAS, Assemblyman de Braga served as an inspiration to
15 all women through her conviction that, “to wish to be equal to men
16 would show a lack of ambition”; and

17 WHEREAS, Marcia de Braga’s name will forever be associated
18 with the preservation of water rights crucial to agriculture in rural
19 Nevada; and

20 WHEREAS, The Silver State International Rodeo in Fallon,
21 which recently celebrated its 25th anniversary, owes its start to
22 Marcia de Braga; and

23 WHEREAS, This proud mother of four treated all children as if
24 they were her own and fought for them throughout her life; now,
25 therefore, be it
