AN ACT relating to wildlife; ~~[Creating]~~ **requiring the Department of Wildlife to establish** the Wildlife Trust Fund; ~~[requiring the Director of the Department of Wildlife to administer the Wildlife Trust Fund;]~~ authorizing the ~~Director~~ **Department** to accept ~~[gifts, grants, donations and endowments of money]~~ **any gift, donation, bequest or devise from any private source** for the Wildlife Trust Fund; requiring the Director to report income and expenditures from the Wildlife Trust Fund to the Chief of the Budget Division of the Department of Administration and the ~~Legislature;~~ **Interim Finance Committee;** and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill ~~[creates]~~ **requires the Department of Wildlife to establish** the Wildlife Trust
2 Fund for the purposes of receiving ~~[gifts, grants, donations and endowments of money]~~ **any**
3 **gift, donation, bequest or devise from any private source** for the ~~Department of Wildlife.~~
4 The Director of the Department is required to administer the Wildlife Trust Fund and is
5 authorized to accept the money for the Wildlife Trust Fund. The money in the Wildlife Trust
6 Fund must be used either for the specified purpose of the donor who donated the money or, if
7 the donor specified no purpose, then ~~[for carrying out the provisions of law administered by]~~
8 ~~the Department]~~ **in the sound discretion of the Director of the Department.** This bill
9 **further establishes that the money in the Wildlife Trust Fund is private money and**
10 **exempts the money in the Wildlife Trust Fund from the statutory requirements relating**
11 **to the expenditure of public money.** Finally, this bill requires the Director to ~~[annually]~~
12 report the income and expenditures of the Wildlife Trust Fund to the Chief of the Budget
13 Division of the Department of Administration and to ~~[the Legislature if it is in session, or if it~~
14 ~~is not in session,~~ to the Interim Finance Committee.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 501 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new
2 section to read as follows:

3 1. The Department shall establish the Wildlife Trust Fund. It is hereby
4 created in the State Treasury.] The Director shall administer the Wildlife Trust
5 Fund and] Department may accept [gifts, grants, donations and endowments of
6 money] any gift, donation, bequest or devise from any private source for deposit
7 in the Wildlife Trust Fund. [The money in the Wildlife Trust Fund must be
8 invested as the money in other state funds is invested. The interest and income
9 earned on the money in the Wildlife Trust Fund must be credited to the Wildlife
10 Trust Fund.] Any money received is private money and not state money. All
11 money must be accounted for in the Wildlife Trust Fund.

12 2. [Money which is donated for a purpose specified by the donor, within the
13 scope of the Director's duties, must be used only for that specified purpose. If no
14 purpose is specified, the money in the Wildlife Trust Fund may be used only to
15 carry out the provisions of this title and chapter 488 of NRS and as provided in
16 NRS 365.535, and the money must not be diverted to any other use.] All of the
17 money in the Wildlife Trust Fund must be deposited in a financial institution to
18 draw interest or to be expended, invested and reinvested pursuant to the specific
19 instructions of the donor, or if no such specific instructions exist, in the sound
20 discretion of the Director. The provisions of NRS 356.011 apply to any accounts
21 in financial institutions maintained pursuant to this section.

22 3. [If all or part of the money accepted by the Director from a donor is not
23 expended before the end of any fiscal year, the remaining balance of the amount
24 donated must remain in the Wildlife Trust Fund until needed for the purpose
25 specified by the donor.] The money in the Wildlife Trust Fund must be budgeted
26 and expended, within any limitations which may have been specified by
27 particular donors, at the discretion of the Director. The Director may authorize
28 independent contractors that may be funded in whole or in part from the money
29 in the Wildlife Trust Fund.

30 4. [Each year, the Director shall submit an itemized statement of the income
31 and expenditures of the Department from the Wildlife Trust Fund to:

32 (a) The Chief of the Budget Division of the Department of Administration
33 together with the other submissions required of the Department pursuant to NRS
34 353.210; and

35 (b) The Legislature if it is in session or, if the Legislature is not in session, to
36 the Interim Finance Committee.] The Director or the Director's designee shall
37 submit semiannually to the Interim Finance Committee a report concerning the
38 investment and expenditure of the money in the Wildlife Trust Fund in such form
39 and detail as the Interim Finance Committee determines is necessary.

40 5. A separate statement concerning the anticipated amount and proposed
41 expenditures of the money in the Wildlife Trust Fund must be submitted to the
42 Chief of the Budget Division of the Department of Administration for his or her
43 information at the same time and for the same fiscal years as the requested
44 budget of the Department submitted pursuant to NRS 353.210. The statement
45 must be attached to the requested budget for the Department when the requested
46 budget is submitted to the Fiscal Analysis Division of the Legislative Counsel
47 Bureau pursuant to NRS 353.211.

1 6. The provisions of chapters 333, 338 and 341 of NRS regarding the
2 expenditure of public money do not apply to the expenditure of money in the
3 Wildlife Trust Fund.

4 **Sec. 2.** NRS 501.356 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 501.356 1. Money received by the Department from:

6 (a) The sale of licenses;

7 (b) Fees pursuant to the provisions of NRS 488.075 and 488.1795;

8 (c) Remittances from the State Treasurer pursuant to the provisions of NRS

9 365.535;

10 (d) Appropriations made by the Legislature; and

11 (e) All other sources, except money derived from the forfeiture of any property
12 described in NRS 501.3857 or money deposited in the Wildlife Heritage Trust
13 Account pursuant to NRS 501.3575, ~~for~~ in the Trout Management Account
14 pursuant to NRS 502.327 **For or in the Wildlife Trust Fund pursuant to section 1 of**
15 **this act,**

16 must be deposited with the State Treasurer for credit to the Wildlife Account in
17 the State General Fund.

18 2. The interest and income earned on the money in the Wildlife Account, after
19 deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to the Account.

20 3. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4, the Department may use
21 money in the Wildlife Account only to carry out the provisions of this title and
22 chapter 488 of NRS and as provided in NRS 365.535, and the money must not be
23 diverted to any other use.

24 4. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 502.250 and 504.155, all fees for the
25 sale or issuance of stamps, tags, permits and licenses that are required to be
26 deposited in the Wildlife Account pursuant to the provisions of this title and any
27 matching money received by the Department from any source must be accounted
28 for separately and must be used:

29 (a) Only for the management of wildlife; and

30 (b) If the fee is for the sale or issuance of a license, permit or tag other than a
31 tag specified in subsection 5 or 6 of NRS 502.250, under the guidance of the
32 Commission pursuant to subsection 2 of NRS 501.181.

33 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2011.
