SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the subsidy for coverage of certain retired persons under the Public Employees' Benefits Program. (BDR 23-1187)

AN ACT relating to the Public Employees' Benefits Program; revising provisions governing the subsidy for coverage of certain retired persons under the Program; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law provides for the payment of a subsidy to cover a portion of the cost of
2 coverage under the Public Employees' Benefits Program for certain retired officers and
3 employees with state service. (NRS 287.046) This bill specifies the subsidy for a retired
4 person whose coverage is provided through the Program by an individual medical plan offered
5 pursuant to the Health Insurance for the Aged Act, 42 U.S.C. §§ 1395 et seq., which is
6 commonly known as Medicare.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 287.046 is hereby amended to read as follows:

287.046 1. The Department of Administration shall establish an assessment
that is to be used to pay for a portion of the cost of premiums or contributions for
the Program for persons who have retired with state service . ~~before January 1,
1994, or under the circumstances set forth in paragraph (a), (b) or (c) of subsection
3.~~

2. The money assessed pursuant to subsection 1 must be deposited into the
Retirees' Fund and must be based upon an amount approved by the Legislature
each session to pay for a portion of the current and future health and welfare
benefits for such retirees.

3. Except as otherwise provided in ~~subsection 4.~~ *subsections ~~6~~ 7 and ~~7~~ 8.*
the portion to be paid to the Program from the Retirees' Fund on behalf of such
persons must be equal to a portion of the cost for each retiree and the retiree's
