AN ACT relating to local governmental planning; providing for the construction of additional bus turnouts at certain locations in certain counties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Under existing law, the regional transportation commission in a county whose population is 400,000 or more (currently Clark County) was required to designate, on or before December 31, 2009, 10 bus stops at which a bus turnout—an area for loading and unloading passengers outside of the lanes of traffic—must be constructed by December 31, 2012. Such a bus turnout must be constructed on land owned by the State or a local government. The commission must fund the construction of the bus turnout. (NRS 278.02587)

Section 1 of this bill requires the regional transportation commission in a county whose population is ~~400,000~~ 700,000 or more (currently Clark County) to designate, on or before December 31, 2011, 15 additional bus stops at which a bus turnout must be constructed by December 31, 2014. Such a bus turnout must be constructed on land owned by the State or a local government. The commission must fund the construction of the bus turnout. Section 1 also requires the commission to establish a technical advisory committee to work cooperatively with utility companies and franchise holders who may be impacted by the construction of a bus turnout. Section 2 of this bill requires the regional transportation commission in a county whose population is ~~400,000~~ 700,000 or more to report to the Legislature on the designation and construction of bus turnouts before the 77th Session of the Legislature convenes.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1           **Section 1.** NRS 278.02587 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2           278.02587   1. Not later than December 31, 2009:  
3           (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection ~~§ 7~~ 7, the commission shall  
4           designate 10 locations in the county that are owned by the State or by local

1 governments and at which a bus turnout must be constructed pursuant to this  
2 section; and

3       (b) For each location designated pursuant to paragraph (a), the commission and  
4 the State or the local government that owns the location shall execute an interlocal  
5 or cooperative agreement that authorizes the construction of a bus turnout at the  
6 location.

7       2. For each location designated pursuant to subsection 1, the commission and  
8 the State or the local government that owns the location shall ensure that a bus  
9 turnout is constructed not later than December 31, 2012.

10       3. *Not later than December 31, 2011:*

11           (a) *Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7, the commission shall  
12 designate 15 locations in the county that are owned by the State or by local  
13 governments and at which a bus turnout must be constructed pursuant to this  
14 section; and*

15           (b) *For each location designated pursuant to paragraph (a), the commission  
16 and the State or the local government that owns the location shall execute an  
17 interlocal or cooperative agreement that authorizes the construction of a bus  
18 turnout at the location.*

19       4. *For each location designated pursuant to subsection 3, the commission  
20 and the State or the local government that owns the location shall ensure that a  
21 bus turnout is constructed not later than December 31, 2014.*

22       5. The commission shall fund the construction of a bus turnout built pursuant  
23 to this section.

24       ~~¶~~ 6. When determining the locations to be designated pursuant to  
25 subsection 1 ~~¶~~ or 3, the commission shall consider, without limitation:

26           (a) The amount of traffic congestion at the location during hours of peak  
27 traffic;

28           (b) The extent of improvements to the location that would need to be  
29 completed before the bus turnout could be constructed;

30           (c) The proximity of the location to an intersection;

31           (d) The frequency with which buses receive and discharge passengers at the  
32 location;

33           (e) The number of bus passengers regularly using the bus stop at the location;

34           (f) The general need for a bus turnout at the location; and

35           (g) Any obstacle that may prevent the completion of the construction of a bus  
36 turnout by the date set forth in subsection 2 ~~¶~~ or 4, as applicable.

37       ~~¶~~ 7. The commission shall not designate more than three locations pursuant  
38 to subsection 1 or 3 that are owned by the State or by the same local government.

39       ~~¶~~ 8. *The commission shall establish a technical advisory committee  
40 which shall:*

41           (a) *As soon as practicable after the locations have been designated pursuant  
42 to subsection 1 and before the development of construction plans for the bus  
43 turnouts, meet with all utility companies and franchise holders whose utilities or  
44 facilities may be impacted by a bus turnout constructed pursuant to that  
45 subsection. Such meetings may include visits to the designated locations.*

46           (b) *Work in a cooperative manner with the affected utilities and franchise  
47 holders to minimize the total cost for the placement or relocation of the affected  
48 utility or facility.*

49       9. As used in this section:

50           (a) "Bus" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 484A.030.

51           (b) "Bus turnout" means a fixed area that is:

52              (1) Adjacent or appurtenant to, or within reasonable proximity of, a public  
53 highway; and

(2) To be occupied exclusively by buses in receiving or discharging passengers.

(c) "Commission" means the regional transportation commission created and organized pursuant to chapter 277A of NRS in a county whose population is ~~400,000~~ 700,000 or more.

(d) "Local government" means any political subdivision of the State, including, without limitation, any county, city, town, board, airport authority, fire protection district, irrigation district, school district, hospital district or other special district which performs a governmental function and which is located within the jurisdiction of the commission.

(e) "Location" means a parcel of real property which:

- (1) Is owned by the State or by a local government;
  - (2) Is adjacent to a public highway; and
  - (3) Contains a bench, shelter or transit stop for

(3) Contains a bench, shelter or transit stop for passengers of public transportation.

(f) "Public highway" means any street, road, alley, thoroughfare, way or place of any kind used by the public or open to the use of the public as a matter of right for the purpose of vehicular traffic.

**Sec. 2.** 1. On or before February 1, 2013, the commission shall submit a report on the designation and construction by the commission of bus turnouts pursuant to NRS 278.02587, as amended by section 1 of this act, and any recommendations for legislation to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmission to the 77th Session of the Nevada Legislature.

**2. As used in this section:**

(a) "Bus" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 484A.030.

(b) "Bus turnout" means a fixed area that is:

(1) Adjacent or appurtenant to, or within reasonable proximity of, a public highway; and

(2) To be occupied exclusively by buses in receiving or discharging passengers.

(c) "Commission" means the regional transportation commission created and organized pursuant to chapter 277A of NRS in a county whose population is ~~400,000~~ 700,000 or more.

(d) "Public highway" means any street, road, alley, thoroughfare, way or place of any kind used by the public or open to the use of the public as a matter of right for the purpose of vehicular traffic.

**Sec. 3.** The provisions of NRS 354.599 do not apply to any additional

enses of a local government that are related to the provisions of the  
Section 4. This article is effective January 1, 1980.
