SUMMARY—Authorizes a person to remove from his or her property ~~a an animal~~ livestock for which he or she has, by contract, provided care and shelter under certain circumstances. (BDR 50-703)

AN ACT relating to ~~a animal~~ livestock; authorizing a person to remove from his or her property ~~a an animal~~ livestock for which he or she has, by contract, provided care and shelter under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law provides for the care of and prevention of cruelty to animals. (NRS 574.050-
2 574.510) This bill provides that: (1) if a person enters into a contract to provide care and
3 shelter for ~~a animal~~ livestock; (2) the person gives 30 days' notice of the termination of
4 the contract and requests the removal of the ~~a animal~~ livestock from his or her property at the
5 end of the contract; and (3) the owner fails to remove the ~~a animal~~ livestock from the person's
6 property at the end of that contract, the person providing care and shelter may remove the
7 ~~a animal~~ livestock from his or her property in several ways. However, before the person may
8 remove the ~~a animal~~ livestock, he or she must provide written notification to the owner by
9 certified mail of his or her intention to remove the ~~a animal~~ livestock if the owner fails to
10 remove the ~~a animal~~ livestock from the person's property. If the owner fails to remove the
11 ~~a animal~~ livestock by the time provided for in the notice, the ~~a animal~~ livestock will be
12 deemed abandoned, and the person may: (1) sell the ~~a animal~~ livestock; (2) give the ~~a animal~~
13 livestock to a society for the prevention of cruelty to animals; (3) return the ~~a animal~~ livestock
14 to the owner; (4) transfer the ~~a animal~~ livestock to another facility that is willing to provide
15 care and shelter for the ~~a animal~~ livestock; or (5) bring an action in court to require the owner
16 to remove the ~~a animal~~ livestock from the person's property. The owner of the ~~a animal~~
17 livestock is liable for any reasonable and actual costs incurred by the person in removing the
18 ~~a animal~~ livestock from his or her property.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 575 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new
2 section to read as follows:

3 ***1. A person who enters into a contract with an owner of ~~a animal~~
4 livestock to provide care or shelter for the ~~a animal~~ livestock on the person's***

1 *property shall give the owner of the [animal] livestock at least 30 days' notice
2 before terminating the contract.*

3 *2. After receiving the notice, if the owner of the [animal] livestock fails to
4 remove the [animal] livestock from the property before the termination of the
5 contract, the [animal] livestock shall be deemed abandoned and the person
6 providing care or shelter for the [animal] livestock may remove the [animal]
7 livestock from his or her property as provided in subsection 3 if:*

8 *(a) The person notifies the owner of the [animal] livestock in writing of the
9 person's intention to remove the [animal] livestock from the property if the owner
10 fails to remove [it] the livestock before the date the contract is terminated; and*

11 *(b) Fourteen days have elapsed since the notice was mailed to the owner of
12 the [animal] livestock. The notice must be mailed, by certified mail, return
13 receipt requested, to the owner of the [animal] livestock at the owner's present
14 address, and if that address is unknown, then at the owner's last known address.*

15 *3. If [an animal] any livestock is deemed abandoned pursuant to subsection
16 2, a person providing care or shelter for [an animal] that livestock may:*

17 *(a) Sell the [animal] livestock;*

18 *(b) Give the [animal] livestock to a society for the prevention of cruelty to
19 animals;*

20 *(c) Return the [animal] livestock to the owner at the owner's present address;*

21 *(d) Transfer the [animal] livestock to another facility which is able to provide
22 care and shelter for the [animal] livestock; or*

23 *(e) Bring a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction to require the
24 owner to remove the [animal] livestock from the person's property.*

25 *4. If the owner of the [animal] livestock fails to remove the [animal]
26 livestock pursuant to subsection 2, the person providing care and shelter for the
27 [animal] livestock may charge and collect any reasonable and actual costs he or
28 she incurs in removing the [animal] livestock pursuant to subsection 3.*

29 *5. [The] Except as otherwise provided in subsection 6, the provisions of this
30 section may be varied by agreement, and the rights conferred by this section may
31 be waived.*

32 *6. The remedies provided for in this section are the exclusive remedies for
33 an action brought pursuant to this section. If a person pursues a remedy not
34 provided for in this section including, without limitation, a civil action for breach
35 of contract or trespass, the provisions of this section do not apply, and the
36 remedies provided for in this section are not available.*

37 *7. As used in this section, "livestock" means:*

38 *(a) All cattle or animals of the bovine species;*

39 *(b) All horses, mules, burros and asses or animals of the equine species;*

40 *(c) All swine or animals of the porcine species;*

41 *(d) All goats or animals of the caprine species; and*

42 *(e) All sheep or animals of the ovine species.*
