AN ACT relating to compensation; exempting creative professionals from requirements relating to compensation for overtime; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

1 **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

2 Existing law requires employers to pay an employee compensation for overtime, but
3 exempts certain kinds of employees, including employees who are employed in a bona fide
4 professional capacity. (NRS 608.018)

5 This bill revises the definition of “professional” to include creative professionals, as
6 described in federal law, **who are not employees of a contractor** within the kinds of
employees who are exempt from the overtime requirement.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 608.0116 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 608.0116 “Professional” means pertaining to ~~and~~:

3 **1.** *An* employee who is licensed or certified by the State of Nevada for and
4 engaged in the practice of law or any of the professions regulated by chapters 623
5 to 645, inclusive, 645G and 656A of NRS.

6 **2.** *A creative professional as described in 29 C.F.R. § 541.302* ~~or~~ **who is not**
an employee of a contractor as that term is defined in NRS 624.020.

8 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2011.
