SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the statewide voter registration list.
(BDR 24-1117)

AN ACT relating to elections; revising provisions relating to the statewide voter registration list; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law requires the Secretary of State to establish and maintain an official statewide voter registration list, which, among other requirements, must be coordinated with appropriate databases of other state agencies and must allow for data to be shared with other states. (NRS 293.675) This bill ~~requires~~ **authorizes the Secretary of State to enter into agreements with state agencies pursuant to which the** state agencies ~~to~~ provide to the Secretary of State any information that the Secretary of State ~~requests and~~ deems necessary for the maintenance of that list. ~~If the information provided is otherwise confidential, the Secretary of State must maintain that confidentiality, except that the~~ **This bill also authorizes the** Secretary of State ~~may~~ **to** provide ~~the~~ information ~~to~~ **requested by** the chief election officer of another state if the Secretary of State is satisfied that the information will be used only for the maintenance of a voter registration list in that state. ~~This~~ **Additionally, this bill** ~~also~~ authorizes the Secretary of State to request from another state any information that the Secretary of State deems necessary for the maintenance of the voter registration list in this State.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 293.675 is hereby amended to read as follows:
293.675 1. The Secretary of State shall establish and maintain an official statewide voter registration list, which may be maintained on the Internet, in consultation with each county and city clerk.
2. The statewide voter registration list must:
(a) Be a uniform, centralized and interactive computerized list;
(b) Serve as the single method for storing and managing the official list of registered voters in this State;

1 (c) Serve as the official list of registered voters for the conduct of all elections
2 in this State;

3 (d) Contain the name and registration information of every legally registered
4 voter in this State;

5 (e) Include a unique identifier assigned by the Secretary of State to each legally
6 registered voter in this State;

7 (f) ~~[Be] [Subject to the provisions of subsections]~~ Except as otherwise
8 provided in subsection 6, [and 7,] be coordinated with the appropriate databases of
9 other agencies in this State;

10 (g) Be electronically accessible to each state and local election official in this
11 State at all times;

12 (h) ~~[Allow] [Subject to the provisions of]~~ Except as otherwise provided in
13 subsection [9,] 7, allow for data to be shared with other states under certain
14 circumstances; and

15 (i) Be regularly maintained to ensure the integrity of the registration process
16 and the election process.

17 3. Each county and city clerk shall:

18 (a) Electronically enter into the statewide voter registration list all information
19 related to voter registration obtained by the county or city clerk at the time the
20 information is provided to the county or city clerk; and

21 (b) Provide the Secretary of State with information concerning the voter
22 registration of the county or city and other reasonable information requested by the
23 Secretary of State in the form required by the Secretary of State to establish or
24 maintain the statewide voter registration list.

25 4. In establishing and maintaining the statewide voter registration list, the
26 Secretary of State shall enter into a cooperative agreement with the Department of
27 Motor Vehicles to match information in the database of the statewide voter
28 registration list with information in the appropriate database of the Department of
29 Motor Vehicles to verify the accuracy of the information in an application to
30 register to vote.

31 5. The Department of Motor Vehicles shall enter into an agreement with the
32 Social Security Administration pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 15483, to verify the
33 accuracy of information in an application to register to vote.
