AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Motor Vehicles for an unanticipated shortfall in kiosk vendor payments; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles, Director's office, the sum of ~~(\$620,036)~~ \$583,614 for an unanticipated shortfall in kiosk vendor payments. This appropriation is supplemental to that made by section 32 of chapter 388, Statutes of Nevada 2009, at page 2113.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
