THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1       **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the
- 2 Department of Motor Vehicles, Director’s office, the sum of ~~1,5630,036~~ \$583,614
- 3 for an unanticipated shortfall in kiosk vendor payments. This appropriation is
- 4 supplemental to that made by section 32 of chapter 388, Statutes of Nevada 2009, at
- 5 page 2113.
- 6       **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
