**SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION**—Expressing opposition to certain proposed actions concerning wild horse and burro herds on federal public lands in Nevada and urging Congress to take certain actions concerning those herds.

1        WHEREAS, The Federal Government manages and controls approximately 87  
2 percent of the land in Nevada, much of it being rangelands populated with herds of  
3 wild horses and burros; and

4        WHEREAS, Those rangelands are subject to multiple uses, including livestock  
5 grazing, hunting, wildlife viewing and other recreation, and as such, a healthy  
6 rangeland is vital to the economic well-being of Nevada; and

7        WHEREAS, The populations of wild horses and burros, if left unmanaged,  
8 double approximately every 5 years, threatening the rangelands with overgrazing  
9 and placing increased pressure on the ability of the rangelands to support livestock  
10 grazing and existing native species of both plants and animals; and

11       WHEREAS, Wild horses and burros are not indigenous species in the rangelands  
12 but were introduced by humans, and it is thus the responsibility of humans to  
13 manage the populations of wild horses and burros in the rangelands; and

14       WHEREAS, Pursuant to the provisions of the Wild Free-Roaming Horses and  
15 Burros Act, 16 U.S.C. §§ 1331 et seq., the Secretary of the Interior is required to  
16 manage wild free-roaming horses and burros in a manner that is designed to  
17 achieve and maintain a thriving natural ecological balance on the public lands and  
18 to determine appropriate management levels of wild free-roaming horses and burros  
19 in a given area in such a manner as to preserve and maintain a thriving natural  
20 ecological balance and multiple-use relationship in that area; now, therefore, be it

21       RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, JOINTLY,  
22 That the members of the 76th Session of the Nevada Legislature hereby express

1 opposition to any proposed expansion of wild horse and burro herd management  
2 areas within Nevada and to the creation of any wild horse and burro preserves on  
3 public lands in Nevada; and be it further

4       RESOLVED, That the members of the Nevada Legislature hereby express  
5 opposition to any amendments to the Wild Free-Roaming Horses and Burros Act,  
6 16 U.S.C. §§ 1331 et seq., that would, if enacted, allow any growth of wild horse  
7 and burro herds in Nevada, allow the expansion of wild horse and burro herd  
8 management areas in Nevada, allow the creation of wild horse and burro preserves  
9 on public lands in Nevada or in any other way negatively impact Nevada; and be it  
10 further

11       RESOLVED, That the members of the Nevada Legislature hereby urge Congress  
12 to take steps necessary to ensure that the Secretary of the Interior complies with  
13 existing laws and regulations relating to wild horses and burros; and be it further

14       RESOLVED, That in complying with those laws and regulations, the Bureau of  
15 Land Management is hereby urged to manage the rangelands in Nevada in a  
16 manner which ensures the increased health and availability of those rangelands for  
17 multiple uses; and be it further

18       RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate prepare and transmit a copy of this  
19 resolution to the Vice President of the United States as the presiding officer of the  
20 United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, each member of  
21 the Nevada Congressional Delegation, the Secretary of the Interior ~~and~~, the  
22 Secretary of Agriculture, the Director of the Bureau of Land Management ~~and~~ and  
23 the Chief of the United States Forest Service; and be it further

24       RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon passage.
