

SENATE BILL NO. 155—SENATOR MCGINNESS

FEBRUARY 16, 2011

Referred to Committee on Government Affairs

SUMMARY—Allows certain unincorporated towns the option to control planning and zoning. (BDR 22-714)

AN ACT relating to zoning; allowing certain unincorporated towns the option to control planning and zoning; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Under existing law, the governing bodies of cities and counties are allowed to regulate and restrict the improvement of land and to control the location and soundness of structures. (NRS 278.020) **Section 1** of this bill allows the governing body of an unincorporated town whose population is 24,000 or more to choose to exercise control over planning and zoning as if it were a city.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 278 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *The governing body of an unincorporated town whose
4 population is 24,000 or more may, by ordinance, elect to be treated
5 as a city pursuant to NRS 278.010 to 278.630, inclusive.*

6 **Sec. 2.** NRS 278.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:
7 278.010 As used in NRS 278.010 to 278.630, inclusive, **and**
8 **section 1 of this act**, unless the context otherwise requires, the
9 words and terms defined in NRS 278.0105 to 278.0195, inclusive,
10 have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.

11 **Sec. 3.** NRS 278.012 is hereby amended to read as follows:
12 278.012 “Cities and counties” means all counties and cities
13 located in counties **[.] and includes an unincorporated town that**



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- 1 *elects to be treated as a city pursuant to section 1 of this act.*
- 2 Carson City is considered as a county.

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
