SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing pet cemeteries and crematories. (BDR 40-979)

EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to pets; reducing the amount of real property required for the operation of a pet cemetery; revising provisions governing crematories for pets; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 **Section 2** of this bill authorizes the governing body of a county, city or town to
2 adopt ordinances for the maintenance and operation of a crematory for pets.
3 **Section 3** of this bill reduces the amount of real property required to have a pet
4 cemetery from 5 acres to 2.5 acres. **Section 4** of this bill removes the requirement
5 that a crematory for pets must be operated by a person who is a cemetery authority,
6 who has a certificate of authority and who operates the crematory on the property
7 of a pet cemetery. Instead, **section 4** requires a crematory for pets which is
8 independent of a cemetery for pets to have an area of a facility that is designated
9 only for the cremation of pets and which complies with any applicable laws.
10 **Section 5** of the bill allows the operator of a crematory for pets to dispose of the
11 remains of a pet which have been left with the crematory when arrangements have
12 not been made within 7 days.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** (Deleted by amendment.)
2 **Sec. 2.** NRS 452.650 is hereby amended to read as follows:
3 452.650 The governing body of a county, city or town may
4 adopt such ordinances for the maintenance and operation of
5 cemeteries for pets ~~and~~ **and crematories for pets**, and for the
6 interment, inurnment and entombment of pets, as it deems

1 appropriate for the public health, safety or welfare. Such an
2 ordinance must not conflict with the provisions of NRS 452.655 to
3 452.700, inclusive.

4 **Sec. 3.** NRS 452.670 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5 452.670 A person shall not operate a cemetery for pets unless:

6 1. The trust fund for the endowment care of the cemetery
7 contains a principal sum of not less than that amount required
8 pursuant to NRS 452.705.

9 2. The cemetery is located on not less than [§] 2.5 acres of real
10 property which:

11 (a) Is dedicated for use as a cemetery for pets pursuant to NRS
12 452.655; and

13 (b) Is not subject to any liens, mortgages or other encumbrances,
14 except those which are subordinate to the dedication of the property
15 for use as a cemetery for pets.

16 **Sec. 4.** NRS 452.675 is hereby amended to read as follows:

17 452.675 1. A person shall not operate a crematory for pets
18 unless the person ~~is a cemetery authority who:~~

19 ~~(a) Also holds a certificate of authority issued pursuant to NRS
20 452.340; and~~

21 ~~(b) Operates the crematory on the property to which that
22 certificate of authority relates.] has a facility with an area
23 designated only for the cremation of pets and which complies with
24 any applicable federal or state statute or regulation or local
25 ordinance.~~

26 2. The provisions of this section do not apply to [a]:

27 (a) A society:

28 ~~(a) Formed~~

29 ~~(1) Which was formed~~ for the purpose of preventing cruelty
30 to animals as described in NRS 574.010; and

31 ~~(b)~~ (2) Which operates a shelter for animals.

32 ~~(b) A cemetery for pets that operates a crematory for pets.~~

33 **Sec. 5.** NRS 452.680 is hereby amended to read as follows:

34 452.680 A cemetery authority ~~or~~ or an operator of a
35 *crematory for pets:*

36 1. May dispose of the remains of any pet which has been left
37 for more than 7 days at the cemetery ~~or~~ or *crematory*, if
38 arrangements have not been made with the cemetery authority or
39 *operator of the pet crematory* for the disposition of the pet.

40 2. Shall post a notice, in a conspicuous place on the grounds of
41 the cemetery ~~or~~ or in the portion of the facility of the *crematory*
42 where the public is allowed apprising the public of the provisions of
43 subsection 1.
