

SENATE BILL NO. 225—SENATOR CEGAVSKE

**SUMMARY**—Establishes provisions relating to the designation of certain hospitals as primary stroke centers. (BDR 40-938)

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AN ACT relating to public health; establishing provisions for the designation of certain hospitals as primary stroke centers; authorizing the State Board of Health to adopt regulations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1        This bill establishes provisions for the Health Division of the Department of  
2 Health and Human Services to acknowledge and prepare a list of hospitals that are  
3 designated as primary stroke centers. This bill also authorizes the State Board of  
4 Health to adopt regulations relating to such designations. This bill further provides  
5 that a licensed hospital which is not designated as a primary stroke center may not  
6 advertise that the hospital is a primary stroke center. This bill does not prohibit any  
7 hospital from providing care to a victim of stroke, even if the hospital does not  
8 receive such a designation.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1        **Section 1.** Chapter 449 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3        ***1. A hospital licensed pursuant to NRS 449.001 to 449.240,  
4 inclusive, may submit to the Health Division proof that the  
5 hospital is certified as a primary stroke center by the Joint  
6 Commission, its successor organization or an equivalent  
7 organization approved by the Health Division. Upon receiving***

1       *proof that a hospital is certified as a primary stroke center, the*  
2       *Health Division shall include the hospital on the list established*  
3       *pursuant to subsection 2.*

4       *2. On or before July 1 of each year, the Health Division shall*  
5       *post a list of the hospitals designated as primary stroke centers on*  
6       *an Internet website maintained by the Health Division.*

7       *3. If a hospital wishes to be included as a primary stroke*  
8       *center on the list established pursuant to subsection 2, the hospital*  
9       *must annually resubmit the proof required pursuant to this*  
10      *section.*

11      *4. The Health Division may remove a hospital from the list*  
12      *established pursuant to subsection 2 if the certificate recognizing*  
13      *the hospital as a primary stroke center issued by the Joint*  
14      *Commission, its successor organization or an equivalent*  
15      *organization, as applicable, is suspended or revoked.*

16      *5. A hospital that is not included on the list established*  
17      *pursuant to subsection 2 as a primary stroke center shall not*  
18      *represent, advertise or imply that the hospital is designated as a*  
19      *primary stroke center.*

20      *6. The provisions of this section do not prohibit a hospital*  
21      *that is licensed pursuant to NRS 449.001 to 449.240, inclusive,*  
22      *from providing care to a victim of stroke if the hospital does not*  
23      *have a designation as a primary stroke center.*

24      *7. The Board may adopt regulations to carry out the*  
25      *provisions of this section and to designate hospitals with similar*  
26      *certifications which are recognized by the Joint Commission, its*  
27      *successor organization or an equivalent organization.*

28      **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on January 1, 2012.
