

SENATE BILL NO. 419—COMMITTEE ON
HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

MARCH 28, 2011

Referred to Committee on Health and Human Services

SUMMARY—Establishes provisions relating to safe injection practices. (BDR 40-518)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: Increases or Newly Provides for Term of Imprisonment in County or City Jail or Detention Facility.
Effect on the State: Yes.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to public health; requiring certain persons and entities that are licensed, registered or certified by the Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services, certain district boards of health or certain boards which license, register or certify health care professionals to attest that they have knowledge of and are in compliance with certain guidelines concerning safe infection practices as a condition of the issuance or renewal of their licenses, registration or certificates; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill requires the Health Division of the Department of Health and Human
2 Services, certain district boards of health and certain boards that license, register or
3 certify health care professionals to require, as a condition of issuing or renewing a
4 license, registration or certificate, that the applicant for issuance or renewal of the
5 license, registration or certificate must attest to knowledge of and compliance with
6 the guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention concerning the
7 prevention of transmission of infectious agents through safe and appropriate
8 injection practices.

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 449 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *The Health Division shall not issue or renew a license for a
4 home for individual residential care unless the applicant for
5 issuance or renewal of the license attests to knowledge of and
6 compliance with the guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control
7 and Prevention concerning the prevention of transmission of
8 infectious agents through safe and appropriate injection practices.*

1 **Sec. 25.** Chapter 630 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***1. The Board shall not issue or renew a license to practice as
4 a physician, physician assistant or perfusionist unless the
5 applicant for issuance or renewal of the license attests to
6 knowledge of and compliance with the guidelines of the Centers
7 for Disease Control and Prevention concerning the prevention of
8 transmission of infectious agents through safe and appropriate
9 injection practices.***

10 ***2. In addition to the attestation provided pursuant to
11 subsection 1, a physician shall attest that any person:***

- 12 ***(a) Who is under the control and supervision of the physician;
13 (b) Who is not licensed pursuant to this chapter; and
14 (c) Whose duties involve injection practices,***

15 ***↳ has knowledge of and is in compliance with the guidelines of
16 the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention concerning the
17 prevention of transmission of infectious agents through safe and
18 appropriate injection practices.***

19 **Sec. 26.** Chapter 632 of NRS is hereby amended by adding

21 ***The Board shall not issue or renew a license to practice as a
22 professional nurse or a practical nurse unless the applicant for
23 issuance or renewal of the license attests to knowledge of and
24 compliance with the guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control
25 and Prevention concerning the prevention of transmission of
26 infectious agents through safe and appropriate injection practices.***

27 **Sec. 27.** Chapter 633 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
28 thereto a new section to read as follows:

29 ***The Board shall not issue or renew a license to practice
30 osteopathic medicine or as a physician assistant unless the
31 applicant for issuance or renewal of the license attests to
32 knowledge of and compliance with the guidelines of the Centers
33 for Disease Control and Prevention concerning the prevention of
34 transmission of infectious agents through safe and appropriate
35 injection practices.***

36 **Sec. 28.** Chapter 634A of NRS is hereby amended by adding
37 thereto a new section to read as follows:

38 ***The Board shall not issue or renew a license to practice
39 Oriental medicine unless the applicant for issuance or renewal of
40 the license attests to knowledge of and compliance with the
41 guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
42 concerning the prevention of transmission of infectious agents
43 through safe and appropriate injection practices.***

1 **Sec. 29.** Chapter 635 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 *The Board shall not issue or renew a license to practice
4 podiatry unless the applicant for issuance or renewal of the license
5 attests to knowledge of and compliance with the guidelines of the
6 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention concerning the
7 prevention of transmission of infectious agents through safe and
8 appropriate injection practices.*

9 **Sec. 30.** Chapter 639 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
10 thereto a new section to read as follows:

11 *The Board shall not approve an application for registration or
12 renewal of registration as a pharmacist or intern pharmacist
13 unless the applicant for issuance or renewal of registration attests
14 to knowledge of and compliance with the guidelines of the Centers
15 for Disease Control and Prevention concerning the prevention of
16 transmission of infectious agents through safe and appropriate
17 injection practices.*

18 **Sec. 31.** Chapter 652 of NRS is hereby amended by adding
19 thereto a new section to read as follows:

20 *The Health Division shall not issue or renew a license to a
21 medical laboratory unless the applicant for issuance or renewal of
22 the license attests that the laboratory director and laboratory
23 personnel have knowledge of and are in compliance with the
24 guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention
25 concerning the prevention of transmission of infectious agents
26 through safe and appropriate injection practices.*
