

SENATE BILL NO. 450—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE
(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Interim Finance Committee for allocation to the State Treasurer for a consultant to assist with the development of a request for proposals for the E-payment and Merchant Services contracts. (BDR S-1249)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Interim Finance Committee for allocation to the State Treasurer for a consultant to assist with the development of a request for proposals for the E-payment and Merchant Services contracts; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 Highway Fund to the Interim Finance Committee the sum of
3 \$25,000 for allocation to the State Treasurer for a consultant to
4 assist with the development of a request for proposals for the
5 E-payment and Merchant Services contracts.
6 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by
7 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
8 June 30, 2013, by the entity to which the appropriation is made or
9 any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or
10 otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the
11 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose



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1 after September 20, 2013, by either the entity to which the money
2 was appropriated or the entity to which the money was subsequently
3 granted or transferred, and must be reverted to the State Highway
4 Fund on or before September 20, 2013.

5 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
