SUMMARY—Makes a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Motor Vehicles for an unanticipated shortfall in kiosk vendor payments. (BDR S-1235)

AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Motor Vehicles for an unanticipated shortfall in kiosk vendor payments; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 Highway Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles, Director's
3 office, the sum of \$583,614 for an unanticipated shortfall in kiosk
4 vendor payments. This appropriation is supplemental to that made
5 by section 32 of chapter 388, Statutes of Nevada 2009, at page 2113.
6 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
