REMARKS FROM THE FLOOR

ASSEMBLYWOMAN CARLTON:

The Assembly Committee on Ways and Means has completed its review of various budgets for the 2011-13 biennium. The closing recommendations for these accounts resulted in General Fund savings of \$8,669 over the biennium.

DCNR Administration (101-4150) DCNR-1:

The Committee recommends approval of the Governor's recommendations to discontinue the Natural Resources Advisory Council, eliminate redundant membership in the Western States Water Council, eliminate the Department's Public Information Officer, and eliminate an Administrative Assistant II position in the Director's Office. These four recommendations provide General Fund savings of \$140,211 in FY 2012 and \$142,173 in FY 2013.

Water Resources (101-4171) DCNR-67:

The Committee recommends approval of the Governor's recommendation to eliminate 5.5 positions from the Division of Water Resources, including two Associate Engineers, two Engineering Technicians, one Administrative Assistant, and half of the Deputy State Engineer in Las Vegas. The Deputy State Engineer will continue as a full-time, fully funded position in the Las Vegas Water Basin account, which has been providing one-half of the position's total costs. The elimination of these positions provides General Fund savings of \$675,562 over the 2011-13 biennium. The Committee also recommends approval of the Governor's recommendation to transfer three General Fund positions from the Water Resources account to the Las Vegas Water Basin account, which is not contained in The Executive Budget. These three positions would continue in their current salary, working capacity, and locations, but would be funded from water assessments in the non-Executive Budget account, and move from classified service to non-classified service. This recommendation provides General Fund savings of \$289,676 over the upcoming biennium.

State Lands (101-4173) DCNR-79:

The Committee voted to recommend approval of the Governor's recommendation to reclassify the existing Management Analyst IV position to a Deputy Administrator; however, instead of providing funds for a 9.6 percent salary increase, the Committee approved funding for a salary increase of approximately 5 percent. This action provides General Fund savings of \$8,669 over the 2011-13 biennium.

DEP Administration (101-3173) DCNR-102:

The Committee supported the Governor's recommendation in the base budget to add grant revenue of \$2 million in each year of the 2011-13 biennium for a new federal Department of Energy (DOE) grant to fund environmental management activities at the Nevada National Security Site (formerly known as the Nevada Test Site). This grant revenue will be transferred to other Division of Environmental Protection accounts, as well as other divisions within the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources. The DOE funds allow the Division to eliminate all General Fund appropriations in the base budget and fill three fee-funded positions that were held vacant due to declining revenue.

DEP Air Quality (101-3185) DCNR-108:

The Committee recommends approval of a technical adjustment to add additional transfers from the Air Quality Management fund of \$121,606 in FY 2012 and \$122,253 in FY 2013 for the personnel and operating expenses of a Deputy Attorney General dedicated to the Bureau of Air Quality Planning and the Bureau of Air Pollution Control. The position was approved at the February 3, 2011, Interim Finance Committee meeting. The Committee also voted to fund new

and replacement equipment with reserve reductions rather than from the Air Quality Management fund. This action provides Air Quality Management fund savings of \$259,274 in FY 2012 and \$100,585 in FY 2013.

DEP Waste Mgmt and Federal Facilities (101-3187) DCNR-120:

The Committee recommends approval of a technical adjustment to add additional transfers from the Hazardous Waste Management fund of \$134,040 in FY 2012 and \$134,761 in FY 2013 for the personnel and operating expenses of a Senior Deputy Attorney General dedicated to the Bureau of Corrective Actions. This position was also approved at the February 3, 2011, Interim Finance Committee meeting.

ASSEMBLYMAN BOBZIEN:

The Assembly Committee on Ways and Means, meeting jointly with the Senate Committee on Finance has completed its review of various budgets for the Department of Public Safety for the 2011-13 biennium. The closing recommendations for these accounts resulted in General Fund savings of \$94,522 over the biennium.

Director's Office (201-4706) PUBLIC SAFETY-1:

The Committee approved the Governor's recommendation to consolidate the Administrative Services Division account within the Director's Office account in order to centralize most of the Department's fiscal and human resource personnel and reduce costs. The Committee approved the Governor's recommendation to reclassify the unclassified Division Administrator of Administrative Services to a classified Administrative Services Officer IV for increased costs totaling \$11,455 for the 2011-13 biennium. The Committee also approved the Governor's recommendation to eliminate the Executive Officer to the Director position for cost allocation reductions totaling \$226,880 in the 2011-13 biennium. Finally, the Committee approved transferring \$962,487 for the 2011-13 biennium to the Highway Patrol account for the cost of interlocal agreements for breathalyzer testing and calibration.

Administrative Services (201-4714) PUBLIC SAFETY-28:

The Committee approved the Governor's recommendation to consolidate administrative positions within the Administrative Services Division and transfer these positions to the Director's Office. The recommendation consolidates five positions from the Highway Patrol, Capitol Police, Justice Grant, and the Division of Investigations. The Committee recommends approving the Governor's recommendation to eliminate an Accounting Assistant and an Administrative Assistant position due to the discontinuation of a department-wide document-scanning program for cost allocation savings totaling \$179,471 during the 2011-13 biennium. With the exception of approving adjustments to reduce authority for unsupported equipment purchases, the Committee approved the remainder of the budget as recommended by the Governor.

Highway Patrol (201-4713) PUBLIC SAFETY-47:

The Committee did not approve the Governor's recommendation to transfer General Funds of \$6,062 over the 2011-13 biennium to the Dignitary Protection account for visiting dignitary protection in order to reflect funding where expenses are incurred. The Committee approved closing the remainder of the budget as recommended by the Governor, including transferring in

\$962,487 over the 2011-13 biennium from the Director's Office account for the cost of interlocal agreements for breathalyzer testing and calibration and changing the source of funding from cost allocation reimbursement to Highway Funds.

Dignitary Protection (101-4738) PUBLIC SAFETY-73:

The Committee did not approve the Governor's recommendation to transfer out General Funds of \$951,024 over the 2011-13 Biennium to the Capitol Police account for Governor's Mansion security. With the exception of staff technical adjustments, the Committee approved closing the remainder of the budget as recommended by the Governor.

Parole Board (101-3800) PUBLIC SAFETY-209:

The Committee approved the Governor's recommendation to eliminate two Administrative Assistants and one Management Analyst position, for General Fund savings of \$321,069 over the 2011-13 biennium. The Committee discussed the possibility of providing funding for four Pardons Board meetings per year, but took no action. The budget includes funding for two Pardons Board meetings per year. The Committee indicated that funding for four Pardons Board meetings may be considered later if funds become available.

Homeland Security (101-3675) PUBLIC SAFETY-215:

The Committee approved eliminating one Grants and Projects Analyst position for a General Fund savings of \$139,216 over the 2011-13 biennium and replacing General Funds of \$269,857 over the 2011-13 biennium with federal funding sources as recommended by the Governor. The Committee approved staff technical adjustments to adjust funding sources for the Department's indirect cost recovery plan, for a General Fund savings of \$8,939 over the 2011-13 biennium.

Highway Safety Plan & Admin (101-4688) PUBLIC SAFETY-173:

The Committee approved the Governor's recommendation to eliminate one Management Analyst position, for a savings of \$131,063 over the 2011-13 biennium, including \$65,531 in Highway Funds. The Committee approved closing the remainder of this account as recommended by the Governor, with staff technical adjustments to align revenues and expenditures with actual federal funding available and adjust funding sources for the Department's indirect cost recovery plan.

Highway Safety Grants Account (201-4721) PUBLIC SAFETY-65:

The Committee approved a technical adjustment to reclassify one Commercial Vehicle Safety Inspector II to a Commercial Vehicle Safety Inspector III. The Governor recommended reclassifying one Commercial Vehicle Safety Inspector II to a Training Officer II; however, the Department of Personnel indicated that reclassification to a Commercial Vehicle Safety Inspector III was more appropriate. The Committee approved closing the remainder of this account as recommended by the Governor, with the exception of staff technical adjustments.

Evidence Vault (101-4701) PUBLIC SAFETY-17:

The Committee approved creating a new Evidence Vault account as recommended by the Governor, with technical adjustments to reduce authority for evidence vault expenditures.

Office of Prof Responsibility (201-4707) PUBLIC SAFETY-13:

The Committee approved changing the methodology used to allocate the Office of Professional Responsibility's operating costs to allocate costs based on the number of civilian as well as sworn personnel investigations, as recommended by the Governor. The recommendation decreases allocated costs paid by General Fund budget accounts by approximately \$93,000 and increases allocated costs paid by Highway Fund accounts by approximately \$110,000 annually. The Committee approved technical adjustments to reduce authority for office rent and equipment purchases.

Child Volunteer Background Checks Trust Acct (101-4710) PUBLIC SAFETY-162:

The Committee approved \$15,087 in General Funds for each year of the 2011-13 biennium for this budget as recommended by the Governor, with approval to continue language in the Appropriations Act that allows for the transfer of General Fund appropriations between fiscal years to address shortfalls in either fiscal year.

Other Department of Public Safety Budget Accounts:

The Committee also reviewed the budgets for the following accounts:

The Committee recommends that these accounts be closed primarily as recommended by the Governor, with approval for Fiscal staff to make necessary technical adjustments.

ASSEMBLYWOMAN SMITH:

The Assembly Committee on Ways and Means has completed its review of the Department of Wildlife's budget accounts and has made the following recommendations for the Department's 2011-13 biennium budget:

Wildlife Administration (101-4452) Wildlife-1:

The 2009 Appropriations and Authorizations Acts instructed the Department of Wildlife to separate the Wildlife Administration account into multiple accounts to facilitate tracking, reporting, accountability, and planning. The Committee approved the Governor's recommended budget reorganization plan for the Department. This plan included eliminating the Wildlife Administration account, as well as the Trout Stamp Program (101-4454) and Boating Program (101-4456) accounts, and completing the breakout of the Director's Office (101-4460) and Operations Division (101-4461) accounts established in FY 2011. In addition, the Committee voted to establish the Conservation Education (101-4462), Law Enforcement (101-4463), Game Management (101-4464), Fisheries Management (101-4465), Diversity (101-4466), and Habitat (101-4467) accounts.

The Committee also approved \$1.6 million in federal and fee funds over the 2011-13 biennium to continue a sagebrush coordinator position that will be located in the Habitat Division as well as program costs that will be divided between the Habitat and Diversity Divisions, as recommended by the Governor. In addition, the Committee approved approximately \$1.6 million for new and replacement equipment in the 2011-13 biennium as recommended by the Governor, with minor adjustments to remove funding for unsupported replacement computer equipment.

Wildlife Fund (101-4458) Wildlife-38:

As part of the budgetary reorganization of the Department of Wildlife, the name of the Obligated Reserve account was changed to the Wildlife Fund. The use of the account was expanded to include unrestricted fees as well as restricted fees. The Wildlife Fund account was also approved to house all of the Department's reserves.

Operations (101-4461) Wildlife-54:

The Committee approved the transfer of a State Land Agent III position to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) as recommended by the Governor, in order to maintain all Land Agent positions in one agency and maintain the integrity of DCNR's land data.

Diversity (101-4466) Wildlife-90:

The Committee approved the Governor's recommendation to reduce General Funds by \$309,267 in the 2011-13 biennium and replace the appropriations with the same amount of habitat conservation fee revenues collected by the Department. The Governor's recommendation includes shifting the Diversity Division's focus to habitat restoration projects from collecting species and habitat data needed to implement the State's Wildlife Action Plan.
