Discussion on interim studies.

S.B. 211 Requires a legislative study of the implementation of the Common Core State Standards in the public schools in Nevada. (BDR S-1099)

S.B. 418 Creates a subcommittee of the Legislative Committee on Health Care to oversee the implementation of federal health care reform in this State. (BDR 40-695)

S.J.R. 15 Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to remove the separate tax rate and manner of assessing and distributing the tax on mines and the proceeds of mines. (BDR C-1151)

S.C.R. 5 Directs the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study concerning the laws of this State governing the protection of children. (BDR R-364)

A.C.R. 12 Directs the Legislative Commission to conduct an interim study concerning the structure and operations of the Nevada Legislature. (BDR R-1312)
