<u>S.B. 167</u> (R1)	Enacts provisions for the designation of certain hospitals as STEMI receiving centers. (BDR 40-229)
<u>S.B. 448</u> (R1)	Instructs the Legislative Committee on Health Care to consider methods to promote federally qualified health centers and rural health clinics. (BDR S-95)
<u>S.B. 450</u> (R1)	Revises the qualifications for certain district health officers. (BDR 40-1081)

<u>S.B. 86</u> (R1)	Requires the Department of Health and Human Services to allocate money for certain programs relating to persons with Alzheimer's disease and other related dementia. (BDR 40-550)
<u>S.B. 97</u> (R1)	Revises provisions relating to hearings concerning children who are removed from their homes. (BDR 38-69)
<u>S.B. 98</u> (R1)	Revises provisions governing certain reasonable efforts made by an agency which provides child welfare services to preserve and reunify the family of a child. (BDR 38-68)
<u>S.B. 99</u> (R1)	Provides for the protection of children in the child welfare system from identity theft. (BDR 38-65)
<u>S.B. 176 (R1)</u>	Revises various provisions concerning investigations of reports of abuse or neglect of a child. (BDR 38-66)
<u>S.B. 453</u> (R1)	Provides for schools to obtain and administer auto-injectable epinephrine. (BDR 40-1195)
