A.B. 287	Authorizes the involuntary court-ordered admission of certain persons with mental illness to programs of community-based or outpatient services under certain circumstances. (BDR 39-163)
<u>A.B. 316</u>	Revises provisions governing medical records. (BDR 40-233)
A.B. 348	Revises provisions relating to foster care. (BDR 38-457)
A.B. 351	Revises provisions governing the medical use of marijuana. (BDR 40-733)
<u>A.B. 362</u>	Provides for the establishment of the HIV/AIDS Drug Donation Program. (BDR 40-757)
A.B. 393	Expands the rights of children placed in foster care. (BDR 38-919)
<u>A.B. 495</u>	Abolishes the Committee on Co-Occurring Disorders. (BDR 40-571)
