Overview of the Activities of the Nevada Pinyon-Juniper Partnership

<u>A.J.R. 2</u>	Urges the Bureau of Land Management and the United States Forest Service to partner with the livestock industry in this State to increase livestock grazing on public lands. (BDR R-18)
<u>A.J.R. 3</u>	Expresses the intent of the Legislature to establish a biomass industry to restore certain ecosystems on public lands. (BDR R-210)
<u>A.J.R. 4</u>	Urges the Bureau of Land Management and the United States Forest Service to assist the State of Nevada with the prevention and suppression of wildfires in this State. (BDR R-209)
<u>A.J.R. 5</u>	Urges Congress to take certain actions concerning federal public lands in Nevada. (BDR R-208)
