SUMMARY—Revises provisions concerning child death review teams. (BDR 38-611)

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to the protection of children; consolidating the administrative teams that review the report and recommendations of a multidisciplinary team appointed to review the death of a child and the Executive Committee to Review the Death of Children; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Under existing law, the director or other authorized representative of an agency which provides child welfare services and the Executive Committee to Review the Death of Children are authorized to appoint a multidisciplinary team to review certain records concerning the death of a child. (NRS 432B.403-432B.407, 432B.409) An administrative team consisting of administrators of agencies which provide child welfare services, and agencies responsible for vital statistics, public health, mental health and public safety is required to review the report and recommendations of a multidisciplinary team. (NRS 432B.408) This bill consolidates the administrative team into the Executive Committee and requires the Executive Committee to review the report and recommendations of a multidisciplinary team. This bill also provides that members of the Executive Committee who are administrators of agencies which provide child welfare services, and agencies responsible for vital statistics, public health, mental health and public safety must serve as nonvoting members of the Executive Committee.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** NRS 432B.408 is hereby amended to read as  
2 follows:

3       432B.408 1. The report and recommendations of a  
4 multidisciplinary team to review the death of a child must be  
5 transmitted ~~[to an administrative team]~~ for review ~~[~~.

6       ~~2. An administrative team must consist of administrators of  
7 agencies which provide child welfare services, and agencies  
8 responsible for vital statistics, public health, mental health and

11 Children established pursuant to NRS 432B.409.~~

12      2. The ~~[administrative team]~~ **Executive Committee** shall  
13 review the report and recommendations and respond in writing to  
14 the multidisciplinary team within 90 days after receiving the report.

15      **Sec. 2.** NRS 432B.409 is hereby amended to read as follows:

16      432B.409 1. The Administrator of the Division of Child and  
17 Family Services shall establish an Executive Committee to Review  
18 the Death of Children, consisting of ~~representatives~~:

19       (a) **Representatives** from multidisciplinary teams formed  
20 pursuant to paragraph (a) of subsection 1 of NRS 432B.405 and  
21 NRS 432B.406, vital statistics, law enforcement, public health and  
22 the Office of the Attorney General.

23       (b) **Administrators of agencies which provide child welfare  
24 services, and agencies responsible for mental health and public  
25 safety, to the extent that such administrators are not already  
26 appointed pursuant to paragraph (a).**

27       2. **Members of the Executive Committee who are  
28 administrators of agencies which provide child welfare services  
29 and of agencies responsible for vital statistics, public health,  
30 mental health and public safety shall serve as nonvoting members.**

31       3. The Executive Committee shall:

32       (a) Adopt statewide protocols for the review of the death of a  
33 child;

34       (b) Adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of NRS  
35 432B.403 to 432B.4095, inclusive;

36       (c) Adopt bylaws to govern the management and operation of  
37 the Executive Committee;

38       (d) Appoint one or more multidisciplinary teams to review  
39 the death of a child from the names submitted to the Executive  
40 Committee pursuant to paragraph (b) of subsection 1 of  
41 NRS 432B.405;

7       4. The Review of Death of Children Account is hereby created  
8 in the State General Fund. The Executive Committee may use  
9 money in the Account to carry out the provisions of NRS 432B.403  
10 to 432B.4095, inclusive.

11      **Sec. 3.** NRS 432B.4095 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12      432B.4095 1. Each member of a multidisciplinary team  
13 organized pursuant to NRS 432B.405, a multidisciplinary team  
14 organized pursuant to NRS 432B.4075 ~~+, an administrative team~~  
15 ~~organized pursuant to NRS 432B.408,~~ or the Executive Committee  
16 to Review the Death of Children established pursuant to NRS  
17 432B.409 who discloses any confidential information concerning  
18 the death of a child is personally liable for a civil penalty of not  
19 more than \$500.

20      2. The Administrator of the Division of Child and Family  
21 Services:

22       (a) May bring an action to recover a civil penalty imposed  
23 pursuant to subsection 1 against a member of a multidisciplinary  
24 team organized pursuant to NRS 432B.4075 ~~+, an administrative~~  
25 ~~team,~~ or the Executive Committee; and

26       (b) Shall deposit any money received from the civil penalty with  
27 the State Treasurer for credit to the State General Fund.

28      3. Each director or other authorized representative of an agency  
29 which provides child welfare services that organized a  
30 multidisciplinary team pursuant to NRS 432B.405:

31       (a) May bring an action to recover a civil penalty pursuant to  
32 subsection 1 against a member of the multidisciplinary team; and

33       (b) Shall deposit any money received from the civil penalty in  
34 the appropriate county treasury.

35      **Sec. 4.** As soon as practicable after July 1, 2013, the  
36 Administrator of the Division of Child and Family Services of the  
37 Department of Health and Human Services shall appoint to  
38 the Executive Committee to Review the Death of Children  
39 established pursuant to NRS 432B.409 the additional members of  
40 the Executive Committee required by paragraph (b) of subsection 1  
41 of NRS 432B.409, as amended by section 2 of this act.

42      **Sec. 5.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.
