**SUMMARY**—Provides for the compilation and publication of the State Administrative Manual. (BDR 18-212)

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AN ACT relating to the State Government; providing for the compilation and publication of the State Administrative Manual, consisting of the policies and procedures adopted and amended by the State Board of Examiners for the Executive Branch of State Government; establishing notice requirements for the adoption, amendment and repeal of such policies and procedures; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1       The Department of Administration currently publishes the State Administrative  
2       Manual, a compilation of policies governing the internal operation of all agencies  
3       of the Executive Branch of the State Government. This bill provides specific  
4       statutory authority and notice requirements for adopting, amending and repealing  
5       these policies and provides specific requirements for compiling and publishing such  
6       a manual.

7       Section 1 of this bill requires the Director of the Department, or the Chief of  
8       the Budget Division of the Department if the Director does not serve as the Chief,  
9       to compile and publish an administrative manual consisting of the policies and  
10      procedures adopted or amended by the State Board of Examiners. Section 1 also  
11      establishes certain procedural requirements to be met by the Director or the Chief,  
12      as applicable, in connection with the adoption, amendment or repeal of such  
13      policies and procedures.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 232 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      *1. The State Administrative Manual is hereby created. The  
4 Director, or the Chief of the Budget Division of the Department if  
5 the Director does not serve as the Chief, shall compile and publish  
6 in the State Administrative Manual any policies and procedures  
7 adopted or amended by the State Board of Examiners pursuant to  
8 NRS 353.040.*

9      *2. In addition to complying with the requirements of NRS  
10 241.020, the Director or the Chief, as applicable, shall, not later  
11 than 30 days before presenting to the State Board of Examiners  
12 any policy or procedure for adoption, amendment or repeal, cause  
13 notice of the proposed action to be posted on the Internet website  
14 used by the State Board of Examiners to provide public notice of  
15 its meetings. The notice must:*

16      *(a) Be accessible through a conspicuous link that appears on  
17 the main page of that website;*

18      *(b) Include the full text of the policy or procedure proposed to  
19 be adopted, amended or repealed, clearly setting forth any  
20 language proposed for addition to or deletion from the policy or  
21 procedure;*

22      *(c) Solicit the submission of written comments by any  
23 interested person to the Director or the Chief, as applicable, for  
24 transmittal to the State Board of Examiners, concerning its  
25 proposed action and set forth the address for the submission of  
26 such comments and the deadline for submission applicable  
27 pursuant to subsection 3; and*

28      *(d) Set forth the date on which the adoption, amendment or  
29 repeal of the policy or procedure becomes effective if action is  
30 taken as proposed.*

31      *3. Any written comments submitted to the Director or the  
32 Chief, as applicable, pursuant to subsection 2 must be submitted  
33 not later than 5 working days before the meeting at which the  
34 proposed adoption, amendment or repeal is to be considered by the  
35 State Board of Examiners and must be entered into the record of  
36 the Board.*

37      **Sec. 2.** NRS 232.212 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
38      232.212 As used in NRS 232.212 to 232.227, inclusive, *and*  
39 *section 1 of this act*, unless the context requires otherwise:

- 40      1. "Department" means the Department of Administration.
- 41      2. "Director" means the Director of the Department.
