

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 308—ASSEMBLYWOMEN NEAL;
AND BUSTAMANTE ADAMS

MARCH 15, 2013

Referred to Concurrent Committees on
Taxation and Ways and Means

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community. (BDR S-557)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to economic development; directing the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Board to develop additional neighborhood revitalization projects; revising the membership of the Board; making an appropriation; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law designates certain areas in the urban core of the Las Vegas Valley as the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community. Existing law also establishes the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Board and requires the Board to prepare, develop and carry out the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Improvement Project to improve infrastructure in the Community. (Chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, pp. 1781-86)

Section 1 of this bill directs the Board, within the limits of available money, to develop additional neighborhood revitalization projects in the Community, which may include various projects relating to economic growth and sustainability, community revitalization and education. **Section 4** of this bill authorizes the Board to accept any gifts, grants or donations for the purpose of preparing, developing and carrying out the additional neighborhood revitalization projects. **Section 3** of this bill increases the membership of the Board by adding one member who is a trustee of the Clark County School District. **Section 5** of this bill makes an appropriation of \$200,000 from the State General Fund to the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Projects Account.



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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page
2 1781, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be
3 designated as section 12.5, immediately following section 12, to
4 read as follows:

5 *Sec. 12.5. The Legislature hereby directs the Board,
6 within the limits of available money, to develop additional
7 neighborhood revitalization projects, which may include,
8 without limitation, projects relating to:*

9 *1. Economic growth and sustainability within the
10 Community, including, without limitation, projects which
11 encourage and assist:*

12 *(a) The development and expansion of opportunity
13 zones within the Community;*

14 *(b) The use of federal money and federal tax credits and
15 participation in programs and awards available through the
16 Federal Government;*

17 *(c) Public and private investment in the Community and
18 collaboration among governmental entities, financial
19 institutions and nonprofit organizations to support
20 economic development in the Community; and*

21 *(d) The development and expansion of job training and
22 job placement programs.*

23 *2. Revitalization of the Community, including, without
24 limitation:*

25 *(a) The construction, repair and refurbishment of
26 educational facilities within the Community and the
27 provision of assistance with issues relating to funding or
28 bonding of such projects as necessary to improve access to
29 education in the Community;*

30 *(b) The provision of assistance to persons applying for
31 participation in revitalization programs and grant programs
32 available through private and governmental entities;*

33 *(c) The construction and operation of community health
34 centers and federally qualified health centers in the
35 Community;*

36 *(d) The development of and assistance in the
37 development of prisoner reentry programs;*

38 *(e) The development and support of programs that
39 encourage community engagement and community
40 leadership; and*

41 *(f) The development and support of initiatives to support
42 the health and nutrition of the residents of the Community.*



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1 3. *Education within the Community, including, without
2 limitation, oversight and coordination of:*

- 3 (a) *Early childhood development programs, K-12
4 education programs, programs designed to improve rates of
5 high school graduation and college readiness programs;*
6 (b) *Programs designed to decrease rates of incarceration
7 for youth in the Community;*
8 (c) *Programs designed to decrease gang violence;*
9 (d) *Programs designed to decrease teen pregnancy rates
10 in the Community;*
11 (e) *Programs of adult care;*
12 (f) *Programs designed to address childhood obesity; and*
13 (g) *Programs designed to encourage faith-based and
14 neighborhood partnerships which are dedicated to
15 improving the Community.*

16 Sec. 2. Chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 1781, is
17 hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated as
18 section 18.5, immediately following section 18, to read as follows:

19 *Sec. 18.5. The Legislature hereby finds and declares
20 that a general law cannot be made applicable to the
21 purposes, objects, powers, rights, privileges, immunities,
22 liabilities, duties and disabilities provided in the Southern
23 Nevada Enterprise Community Infrastructure Improvement
24 Act because of the number of atypical factors and special
25 conditions relating thereto, including the economic and
26 geographic diversity of the local governments of this State,
27 the unique growth patterns occurring in Clark County, the
28 special conditions experienced in the City of Las Vegas
29 related to the need to revitalize specific areas of the City of
30 Las Vegas to ensure that the residents of more densely
31 populated urban areas are provided with a safe environment
32 in which to live and work and the necessity to ameliorate
33 hardships imposed on specific areas of the City of Las
34 Vegas as a consequence of projects undertaken for the
35 general benefit of the people of this State.*

36 Sec. 3. Section 8 of chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, as
37 amended by chapter 481, Statutes of Nevada 2009, at page 2771, is
38 hereby amended to read as follows:

39 Sec. 8. 1. The Southern Nevada Enterprise
40 Community Board is hereby created.

41 2. The Board consists of ~~nine~~ 10 members, appointed
42 in consultation with residents of the Community, as follows:

43 (a) One member of the Nevada Congressional Delegation
44 selected from among its membership or his designee;



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1 (b) One member of the Assembly and one member of the
2 Senate who represent the Community selected by the
3 Legislative Commission;

4 (c) One member of the Clark County Board of County
5 Commissioners selected from among its membership;

6 (d) One member of the Las Vegas City Council from
7 among its membership;

8 (e) One member of the North Las Vegas City Council
9 from among its membership;

10 (f) ***One member of the Board of Trustees of the Clark
11 County School District from among its membership;***

12 (g) Two residents of the Community, recommended and
13 selected by the Stop the F Street Closure, LLC; and

14 ~~(g)~~ (h) A representative of the private sector appointed
15 by the Chamber of Commerce established in the Community.

16 3. Each member of the Board serves for a term of 3
17 years. A vacancy on the Board must be filled in the same
18 manner as the original appointment. A member may be
19 reappointed to the Board.

20 4. The members of the Board shall elect a Chairman and
21 Vice Chairman by majority vote. After the initial election, the
22 Chairman and Vice Chairman shall hold office for a term of 1
23 year beginning on August 1 of each year. If a vacancy occurs
24 in the chairmanship or vice chairmanship, the members of the
25 Board shall elect a Chairman or Vice Chairman, as
26 appropriate, from among its members for the remainder of the
27 unexpired term.

28 5. The City of Las Vegas shall provide administrative
29 support for the Board.

30 **Sec. 4.** Section 13 of chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, as
31 amended by chapter 481, Statutes of Nevada 2009, at page 2772, is
32 hereby amended to read as follows:

33 Sec. 13. The Board may accept any gifts, grants or
34 donations for the purpose of preparing, developing and
35 carrying out the Project ~~H~~, or such additional projects as
36 may be directed by the Legislature.

37 **Sec. 5.** There is hereby appropriated from the State General
38 Fund to the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Projects
39 Account created by NRS 278.750 the sum of \$200,000.

40 **Sec. 6.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.
