**SUMMARY**—Revises provisions relating to the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community. (BDR S-557)

**FISCAL NOTE:** Effect on Local Government: No.

Effect on the State: Contains Appropriation not included in Executive Budget.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to economic development; directing the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Board to develop additional neighborhood revitalization projects; revising the membership of the Board; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

Existing law designates certain areas in the urban core of the Las Vegas Valley as the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community. Existing law also establishes the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Board and requires the Board to prepare, develop and carry out the Southern Nevada Enterprise Community Improvement Project to improve infrastructure in the Community. (Chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, pp. 1781-86)

**Section 1** of this bill directs the Board, within the limits of available money, to develop additional neighborhood revitalization projects in the Community, which may include various projects relating to economic growth and sustainability, community revitalization and education. **Section 4** of this bill authorizes the Board to accept any gifts, grants or donations for the purpose of preparing, developing and carrying out the additional neighborhood revitalization projects. **Section 3** of this bill revises the qualifications for certain members of the Board and increases the membership of the Board by adding one member who is a trustee of the Clark County School District and one member who is a member of the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** Chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page  
2 1781, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be  
3 designated as section 12.5, immediately following section 12, to  
4 read as follows:

5       *Sec. 12.5. The Legislature hereby directs the Board,  
6 within the limits of available money, to develop additional  
7 neighborhood revitalization projects, which may include,  
8 without limitation, projects relating to:*

9       *1. Economic growth and sustainability within the  
10 Community, including, without limitation, projects which  
11 encourage and assist:*

12       *(a) The development of a promise neighborhood within  
13 the Community;*

14       *(b) The use of federal money and federal tax credits and  
15 participation in programs and awards available through the  
16 Federal Government;*

17       *(c) Public and private investment in the Community and  
18 collaboration among governmental entities, the private  
19 sector and nonprofit organizations to support  
20 the Community and economic development in the  
21 Community; and*

22       *(d) The development and expansion of job training and  
23 job placement programs.*

24       *2. Revitalization of the Community, including, without  
25 limitation:*

26       *(a) The construction, repair and refurbishment of  
27 educational facilities within the Community and the  
28 provision of assistance with issues relating to funding or  
29 bonding of such projects as necessary to improve access to  
30 education in the Community;*

31       *(b) The provision of assistance to persons applying for  
32 participation in revitalization programs and grant programs  
33 available through private and governmental entities;*

34       *(c) The construction and operation of community health  
35 centers and federally qualified health centers in the  
36 Community;*

37       *(d) The development of and assistance in the  
38 development of prisoner reentry programs;*

39       *(e) The development and support of programs that  
40 encourage community engagement and community  
41 leadership; and*



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1                   (f) *The development and support of initiatives to support  
2 the health and nutrition of the residents of the Community.*

3                   3. *Education within the Community, including, without  
4 limitation, oversight and coordination of:*

5                   (a) *Early childhood development programs, English  
6 language learner programs, K-12 education programs,  
7 programs designed to improve rates of high school  
8 graduation and college readiness programs;*

9                   (b) *Programs designed to decrease rates of incarceration  
10 for youth in the Community;*

11                   (c) *Programs designed to decrease gang violence;*

12                   (d) *Programs designed to decrease teen pregnancy rates  
13 in the Community;*

14                   (e) *Programs of adult care;*

15                   (f) *Programs designed to address childhood obesity; and*

16                   (g) *Programs designed to encourage faith-based and  
17 neighborhood partnerships which are dedicated to  
18 improving the Community.*

19                   Sec. 2. Chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 1781, is  
20 hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be designated as  
21 section 18.5, immediately following section 18, to read as follows:

22                   ***Sec. 18.5. The Legislature hereby finds and declares  
23 that a general law cannot be made applicable to the  
24 purposes, objects, powers, rights, privileges, immunities,  
25 liabilities, duties and disabilities provided in the Southern  
26 Nevada Enterprise Community Infrastructure Improvement  
27 Act because of the number of atypical factors and special  
28 conditions relating thereto, including the economic and  
29 geographic diversity of the local governments of this State,  
30 the unique growth patterns occurring in Clark County, the  
31 special conditions experienced in the City of Las Vegas  
32 related to the need to revitalize specific areas of the City of  
33 Las Vegas to ensure that the residents of more densely  
34 populated urban areas are provided with a safe environment  
35 in which to live and work and the necessity to ameliorate  
36 hardships imposed on specific areas of the City of Las  
37 Vegas as a consequence of projects undertaken for the  
38 general benefit of the people of this State.***

39                   Sec. 3. Section 8 of chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, as  
40 amended by chapter 481, Statutes of Nevada 2009, at page 2771, is  
41 hereby amended to read as follows:

42                   Sec. 8. 1. The Southern Nevada Enterprise  
43 Community Board is hereby created.

44                   2. The Board consists of ~~nine~~ 11 members, appointed  
45 in consultation with residents of the Community, as follows:



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- 1                         (a) One member of the Nevada Congressional Delegation  
2                         selected from among its membership or his designee;  
3                         (b) One member of the Assembly and one member of the  
4                         Senate who represent the Community selected by the  
5                         Legislative Commission;  
6                         (c) One member of the Clark County Board of County  
7                         Commissioners selected from among its membership;  
8                         (d) One member of the Las Vegas City Council from  
9                         among its membership;  
10                         (e) One member of the North Las Vegas City Council  
11                         from among its membership;  
12                         (f) *One member of the Board of Trustees of the Clark  
13                         County School District from among its membership;*  
14                         (g) *One member of the Board of Regents of the  
15                         University of Nevada;*  
16                         (h) Two residents of the Community, ~~recommended and  
17                         selected by the Stop the F Street Closure, LLC; which must  
18                         include a representative of a local housing agency and a  
19                         parent of a pupil enrolled in a school located in the  
20                         Community;~~ and  
21                         ~~(g)~~ (i) A representative of the private sector appointed  
22                         by the Chamber of Commerce established in the Community.  
23                         3. Each member of the Board serves for a term of 3  
24                         years. A vacancy on the Board must be filled in the same  
25                         manner as the original appointment. A member may be  
26                         reappointed to the Board.  
27                         4. The members of the Board shall elect a Chairman and  
28                         Vice Chairman by majority vote. After the initial election, the  
29                         Chairman and Vice Chairman shall hold office for a term of 1  
30                         year beginning on August 1 of each year. If a vacancy occurs  
31                         in the chairmanship or vice chairmanship, the members of the  
32                         Board shall elect a Chairman or Vice Chairman, as  
33                         appropriate, from among its members for the remainder of the  
34                         unexpired term.  
35                         5. ~~The City of Las Vegas shall provide administrative  
36                         support for the Board.~~ *Clark County, the City of Las Vegas  
37                         and the City of North Las Vegas shall each, on an annually  
38                         rotating basis, provide administrative support for the Board.  
39                         A member of the Board who is unable to attend a meeting of  
40                         the Board may select a designee to attend the meeting in  
41                         place of the member. A designee selected pursuant to this  
42                         subsection may not vote on any matter before the Board.*



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1       **Sec. 4.** Section 13 of chapter 407, Statutes of Nevada 2007, as  
2       amended by chapter 481, Statutes of Nevada 2009, at page 2772, is  
3       hereby amended to read as follows:

4           Sec. 13. The Board may accept any gifts, grants or  
5       donations for the purpose of preparing, developing and  
6       carrying out the Project ~~H~~, *or such additional projects as*  
7       *may be directed by the Legislature.*
