

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 360—ASSEMBLYMEN HORNE,
HEALEY; BOBZIEN AND KIRKPATRICK

MARCH 18, 2013

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to gaming. (BDR 41-24)

AN ACT relating to gaming; providing certain restrictions governing restricted licenses to operate gaming; providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Existing law: (1) defines a “restricted license” as a state gaming license to
2 operate not more than 15 slot machines at an establishment in which the operation
3 of slot machines is incidental to the primary business of the establishment; and (2)
4 provides that such a license may only be granted to the operator of the primary
5 business or to a licensed operator of a slot machine route. (NRS 463.0189, 463.161)
6 This bill provides that a restricted license may only be granted at certain
7 establishments if the establishment contains: (1) a minimum of 2,500 square feet of
8 space available for patrons; (2) a permanent, physical bar; and (3) a restaurant
9 which meets certain requirements.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 463.161 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 463.161 ***1.*** A license to operate 15 or fewer slot machines at
3 an establishment in which the operation of slot machines is
4 incidental to the primary business conducted at the establishment
5 may only be granted to the operator of the primary business or to a
6 licensed operator of a slot machine route.
7 ***2.*** *A license to operate 15 or fewer slot machines at an*
8 *establishment which is a bar, tavern, saloon or other similar*
9 *location licensed to sell alcoholic beverages by the drink, for*



1 *consumption on the premises, may only be granted if the*
2 *establishment meets all the following conditions:*

3 *(a) The establishment contains a minimum of 2,500 square*
4 *feet of space available for use by patrons.*

5 *(b) The establishment contains a permanent, physical bar. If*
6 *the establishment has:*

7 *(1) One to seven slot machines, all slot machines must be*
8 *embedded in the bar.*

9 *(2) Eight to 15 slot machines, at least eight of the slot*
10 *machines must be embedded in the bar.*

11 *(c) The establishment contains a restaurant that meets all the*
12 *following requirements:*

13 *(1) The restaurant must provide seating for at least 25*
14 *patrons. For the purposes of determining the number of seats*
15 *pursuant to this subparagraph, seating that is related to or*
16 *associated with gaming employees, stools at the bar, and seating in*
17 *a lounge or outside dining area must not be counted.*

18 *(2) The restaurant must contain a kitchen which must be*
19 *operated not less than 12 hours each day that the establishment is*
20 *open for business.*

21 *(3) If the restaurant allows admittance of minors, the*
22 *dining room must be divided and separated from the bar area by a*
23 *structural barrier sufficient to exclude minors from the bar area.*
24 *If the restaurant does not allow the admittance of minors, a*
25 *physical separation from the bar is not required, but a sign must*
26 *be posted at the entrance of the establishment which states that the*
27 *entrance of minors is prohibited.*

28 *3. As used in this section:*

29 *(a) "Bar" means a physical structure with a flat horizontal*
30 *counter, on one side of which alcoholic liquors are kept and*
31 *maintained, where seats may be placed for patrons to sit on the*
32 *side opposite from where the alcoholic liquors are kept, and where*
33 *the sale and service of alcoholic beverages are by the drink across*
34 *such structure.*

35 *(b) "Restaurant" means a space operated in conjunction with*
36 *an establishment, which is kept, used, maintained, advertised and*
37 *held out to the public as a place where hot meals are prepared and*
38 *served on premises.*

39 **Sec. 2.** The amendatory provisions of this act apply to any
40 license to operate 15 or fewer slot machines granted on or after
41 July 1, 2013.

42 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.
