AN ACT making an appropriation from the State Highway Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles for the creation and maintenance of a branch office in Assembly District No. 6 in Clark County; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the State
2 Highway Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles for the creation
3 and maintenance of a branch office of the Department in Assembly
4 District No. 6 in Clark County:

5 For the Fiscal Year 2013-2014..... \$135,000
6 For the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 \$135,000

7 **Sec. 2.** Any balance of the sums appropriated by section 1 of
8 this act remaining at the end of the respective fiscal years must not
9 be committed for expenditure after June 30 of the respective fiscal
10 years by the Department of Motor Vehicles or any entity to which
11 money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in
12 any manner, and any portion of the appropriated money remaining
13 must not be spent for any purpose after September 19, 2014, and
14 September 18, 2015, respectively, by either the Department of



1 Motor Vehicles or the entity to which the money appropriated or the
2 entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred,
3 and must be reverted to the State Highway Fund on or before
4 September 19, 2014, and September 18, 2015, respectively.

5 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
