

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 469—COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

SUMMARY—Makes appropriations to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the replacement and maintenance of emergency response, firefighting and other critical equipment and vehicles. (BDR S-1186)

AN ACT making appropriations to the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources for the replacement and maintenance of emergency response, firefighting and other critical equipment and vehicles; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to:

1. The Division of Forestry of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, the sum of \$1,311,065 for the replacement and maintenance of emergency response and firefighting equipment and vehicles; and

2. To the Department for the forestry conservation camps, the sum of \$2,559,766 for the replacement of critical equipment and vehicles, including equipment and vehicles used to respond to natural disasters and needed to move crews quickly out of dangerous situations.

- 1 **Sec. 2.** Any remaining balance of the appropriations made by
2 section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after
3 June 30, 2015, by the State Department of Conservation and Natural
4 Resources or any entity to which money from the appropriations is
5 granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of
6 the appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any
7 purpose after September 18, 2015, by either the Department or the
8 entity to which the money was subsequently granted or transferred,
9 and must be reverted to the State General Fund on or before
10 September 18, 2015.
11 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
