

ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 77—ASSEMBLYMAN HICKEY

PREFILED FEBRUARY 1, 2013

Referred to Committee on Legislative Operations and Elections

SUMMARY—Requires a cooling-off period before a former State Legislator may serve as a paid lobbyist. (BDR 17-436)

AN ACT relating to the Legislature; prohibiting a former State Legislator from receiving compensation or other consideration to serve as a lobbyist to the Legislature for a period of 2 years after leaving office; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill prohibits a former State Legislator from receiving compensation or
2 other consideration to serve as a lobbyist to the Legislature for 2 years after leaving
3 office.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 218A of NRS is hereby amended by
2 adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
3 *1. A former Legislator shall not receive compensation or*
4 *other consideration to serve as a lobbyist for a period of 2 years*
5 *after leaving office.*
6 *2. As used in this section:*
7 *(a) "Consideration" means a gift, salary, payment,*
8 *distribution, loan, advance or deposit of money or anything of*
9 *value and includes, without limitation, a contract, promise or*
10 *agreement, whether or not legally enforceable.*
