AN ACT relating to water; requiring the Legislative Committee on Public Lands to conduct a study concerning water conservation and alternative sources of water for Nevada communities; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Under existing law, the Legislative Committee on Public Lands is authorized to review and comment on the laws, regulations and policies relating to the use, allocation and management of water in this State. (NRS 218E.525) This bill requires the Committee to conduct a study concerning water conservation and alternative sources of water for Nevada communities and to submit a report of its findings and any recommendations for legislation to the 78th Session of the Nevada Legislature.

1 ***WHEREAS, The waters of the State of Nevada are among its most precious and***
2 ***vital resources; and***

3 ***WHEREAS, The State of Nevada is one of the most arid states in the United***
4 ***States and its limited surface water and groundwater resources have been depleted***
5 ***by recent drought conditions in the Colorado River Basin and the Great Basin; and***

6 ***WHEREAS, Adequate, long term supplies of water are essential to Nevada's***
7 ***economic future, valued quality of life and natural environment, and it is apparent***
8 ***that Nevada's urban areas will need alternative sources of water in the future to***
9 ***support growth and development; and***

10 ***WHEREAS, One of the duties of the Legislative Committee on Public Lands is***
11 ***to review and comment on issues relating to water resources in this State; now,***
12 ***therefore,***



1 THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
2 SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

4 **Section 1.** 1. The Legislative Committee on Public Lands shall conduct a
5 study during the 2013-2014 interim concerning water conservation and alternative
6 sources of water for Nevada communities. The study must include, without
7 limitation, a comprehensive review of ~~¶ all of the following:~~

8 (a) Issues relating to water resources in this State;

9 (b) Studies ~~relating to~~ quantifying water use, surface water resources and
10 groundwater resources, including, without limitation, increased water supply
11 through conservation; ~~and~~

12 (c) The total consumptive use of water in this State, calculated on the basis
13 of gallons per capita per day;

14 (d) Alternative sources of water, including, without limitation, desalination of
15 ~~ocean~~ water, ~~reclaiming wastewater, using graywater, capturing rainwater,~~
16 ~~interbasin transfers of groundwater, conservation of water used for~~
17 ~~agricultural purposes, water conservation in urban areas~~ and cloud seeding ~~¶~~
18 ~~and the reuse of water, including, without limitation, reclaiming wastewater,~~
19 ~~using graywater and capturing rainwater; and~~

20 (e) Efforts that may be taken by the State of Nevada to ensure the
21 equitable apportionment of groundwater in basins that have boundaries which
22 extend outside the borders of the State of Nevada.

23 2. In addition to any report required pursuant to NRS 218E.525, the
24 Committee shall, on or before February 1, 2015, submit a report of its findings and
25 any recommendations for legislation to the Director of the Legislative Counsel
26 Bureau for transmittal to the 78th Session of the Nevada Legislature.
