**SUMMARY**—Revises provisions relating to early childhood education programs.  
(BDR 38-199)

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AN ACT relating to children; providing for the establishment by statute of the **Nevada** Early Childhood Advisory Council; prescribing the membership and duties of the Council; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1      **The Federal law requires, as a condition of state participation in the federal Head**  
2      **Start program, the Governor to designate or establish an advisory council on early**  
3      **childhood education and care. (42 U.S.C. § 9837b) In fulfillment of this obligation,**  
4      Nevada Early Childhood Advisory Council was created by an executive order of the Governor  
5      on September 11, 2009, and was continued by executive order on July 14, 2011. By the terms  
6      of the executive order signed on July 14, 2011, the Council will cease to exist on July 31,  
7      2013. This bill statutorily **provides for the establishment of establishes the Nevada** Early  
8      Childhood Advisory Council by the **Director of the Department of Health and Human**  
9      **Services, Governor.** This bill also sets forth the membership of the Council, which must be  
10     appointed by the **Director, Governor** and include **[(1) one member who is a representative**  
11     **of the Department of Education; (2) one member who is a representative of a nonprofit**  
12     **organization located in southern Nevada that provides early childhood education programs;**  
13     **(3) one member who is a representative of a] membership as required by federal law, plus**  
14     **representatives of nonprofit organizations located in northern and southern**  
15     **Nevada that provide early childhood education programs, and (4) such other**  
16     **members as the Director determines appropriate.]** The statutory Council has substantially the  
17     same duties as the Council created by executive order but must also establish, in cooperation  
18     with the State Board of Education, guidelines for evaluating the school readiness of children.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1        **Section 1.** Chapter 432A of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new  
2 section to read as follows:

3        **1. *The Director shall establish the Nevada Early Childhood Advisory  
4 Council [within the Department] is hereby established as the state advisory  
5 council on early childhood education and care required to be established  
6 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 9837b(b)(1)(A)(i). The membership of the Council must  
7 be appointed by the Director, Governor and include, without limitation:***

8            **(a) One member who is a representative of the Health Division whose duties  
9 include responsibility for child care;**

10          **(b) One member who is a representative of the Department of Education;**

11          **(c) One member who is a representative of the Department of Education  
12 whose duties include responsibilities for programs under section 619 or part C of  
13 the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, 20 U.S.C. §§ 1400 et seq.;**

14          **(d) One member who is a representative of the boards of trustees of the  
15 school districts in this State;**

16          **(e) One member who is a representative of the Nevada System of Higher  
17 Education;**

18          **(f) One member who is a representative of local providers of early childhood  
19 education and developmental services;**

20          **(g) One member who is a representative of Head Start agencies in this State,  
21 including, without limitation, migrant and seasonal Head Start programs and  
22 Indian Head Start programs;**

23          **(h) One member who is appointed or designated pursuant to 42 U.S.C. §  
24 9837b(a)(3)(A);**

25          **(i) One member who is a representative of the Division of Mental Health and  
26 Development Services of the Department;**

27          **(j) One member who is a representative of a nonprofit organization located  
28 in southern Nevada that provides early childhood education programs;**

29          **(k) One member who is a representative of a nonprofit organization  
30 located in northern Nevada that provides early childhood education programs;  
31 and**

32          **(l) Such other members as the Director, Governor determines are  
33 appropriate.**

34        **2. The Council shall:**

35            **(a) Work to strengthen state-level coordination and collaboration among the  
36 various sectors and settings of early childhood education programs.**

37            **(b) Conduct periodic statewide assessments of needs relating to the quality  
38 and availability of programs and services for children who are in early childhood  
39 education programs.**

40            **(c) Identify opportunities for and barriers to coordination and collaboration  
41 among early childhood education programs funded in whole or in part by the  
42 Federal Government, the State or a local government.**

43            **(d) Develop recommendations for:**

44              **(I) Increasing the participation of children in early childhood education  
45 programs funded in whole or in part by the Federal Government, the State or a  
46 local government, including, without limitation, providing information on such  
47 programs to underrepresented and special populations;**

1                   (2) *The establishment or improvement of core elements of the early  
2 childhood system in this State, including, without limitation, a statewide unified  
3 system for collecting data relating to early childhood education programs;*

4                   (3) *A statewide professional development system for teachers engaged in  
5 early childhood education; and*

6                   (4) *The establishment of statewide standards for early childhood  
7 education programs in this State.*

8                   (e) *Assess the capacity and effectiveness of institutions of higher education  
9 in this State in developing teachers in the field of early childhood education.*

10                  (f) *Establish, in cooperation with the State Board of Education, guidelines  
11 for evaluating the school readiness of children. The guidelines must:*

12                   (1) *Be based on national school readiness indicators;*

13                   (2) *Address the following components of school readiness:*

14                   (I) *Physical and developmental health;*

15                   (II) *Social and emotional development;*

16                   (III) *Approaches to learning;*

17                   (IV) *Language and early literacy development; and*

18                   (V) *Cognition and general knowledge.*

19                   (g) *Develop recommendations for increasing parental involvement and  
20 family engagement in early childhood education programs.*

21                   (h) *Perform such other duties relating to early childhood education  
22 programs as designated by the ~~Director~~ or Governor.*

23                  3. *The Council may accept gifts, grants and donations from any source for  
24 the support of the Council in carrying out the provisions of this section.*

25                  Sec. 2. On or before February 1, 2015, the Nevada Early Childhood  
26 Advisory Council established ~~pursuant to~~ by section 1 of this act shall prepare and  
27 submit a report to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to  
28 the 78th Session of the Nevada Legislature on the work of the Council relating to  
29 the duties of the Council set forth in section 1 of this act.

30                  Sec. 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1 of this act, the Nevada  
31 Early Childhood Advisory Council created by the Governor by executive order on  
32 September 11, 2009, and continued by executive order on July 14, 2011, shall be  
33 deemed to be the Nevada Early Childhood Advisory Council ~~required to be~~  
34 established ~~by the Director of the Department of Health and Human Services~~  
35 pursuant to section 1 of this act until the ~~Director~~ Governor appoints the  
36 members of the Advisory Council pursuant to subsection 1 of section 1 of this act.  
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                Sec. 4. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
