S.B. No. 100—Revises provisions relating to certain providers of emergency medical services. (BDR 40-501)



Section 51.5 of Senate Bill No. 100 First Reprint is hereby amended as follows:

1 **Sec. 51.5.** Notwithstanding the provisions of NRS 450B.025, 450B.065,
2 450B.085, 450B.1905, 450B.191 and 450B.195, as amended by sections 5, 7, 9, 18,
3 19 and 21 of this act, any person who, on December 31, 2013, holds a certificate as
4 an emergency medical technician, **intermediate emergency medical technician or**
5 advanced emergency medical technician ~~for paramedic~~ is exempt from the training
6 requirements for certification prescribed pursuant to the applicable provisions of
7 NRS 450B.1905, 450B.191 or 450B.195, as amended by sections 18, 19 and 21 of
8 this act, through December 31, 2015.
