AN ACT relating to interscholastic events; revising provisions relating to the rules and regulations of the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Under existing regulations, the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association may
2 approve certain games, contests and meets in which all-star teams participate if the game,
3 contest or meet is approved by the National Collegiate Athletics Association, or its successor
4 organization, and the National Federation of State High School Associations, or its successor
5 organization. (NAC 386.693) **Section 1** of this bill provides that the rules and regulations
6 adopted by the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association must provide criteria to be used
7 by the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association when determining whether to approve or
8 disapprove the staging of all-star games, contests or meets by any other organization and the
9 participation of all-star teams in games, contests and meets without approval from any other
10 organization. **Section 3** of this bill requires the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association,
11 on or before June 30, 2014, to amend its rules and regulations as necessary to conform to the
12 provisions of **section 1**. **Section 3.5 of this bill authorizes the Nevada Interscholastic**
13 **Activities Association to approve the staging of all-star games, contests or meets by any**
14 **other organization and the participation of all-star teams in games, contests or meets**
15 **without approval from any other organization during the period between the passage**
16 **and approval of this bill and the adoption by the Nevada Interscholastic Activities**
17 **Association of the rules and regulations required by section 3.**

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 386 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new
2 section to read as follows:

3 *The rules and regulations adopted by the Nevada Interscholastic Activities*
4 *Association pursuant to NRS 386.430 must provide criteria to be used by the*
5 *Association when determining whether to approve or disapprove:*

6 1. *The staging of an all-star game, contest or meet by any other*
7 *organization; and*

8 2. *The participation of an all-star team in a game, contest or meet*
9 *regardless of whether the game, contest or meet is approved by any other*
10 *organization.*

11 **Sec. 2.** NRS 386.430 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12 386.430 1. The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association shall adopt
13 rules and regulations in the manner provided for state agencies by chapter 233B of
14 NRS as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of NRS 386.420 to 386.470,
15 inclusive ~~H~~, *and section 1 of this act.* The regulations must include provisions
16 governing the eligibility and participation of homeschooled children in
17 interscholastic activities and events. In addition to the regulations governing
18 eligibility, a homeschooled child who wishes to participate must have on file with
19 the school district in which the child resides a current notice of intent of a
20 homeschooled child to participate in programs and activities pursuant to NRS
21 392.705.

22 2. The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association shall adopt regulations
23 setting forth:

24 (a) The standards of safety for each event, competition or other activity
25 engaged in by a spirit squad of a school that is a member of the Nevada
26 Interscholastic Activities Association, which must substantially comply with the
27 spirit rules of the National Federation of State High School Associations, or its
28 successor organization; and

29 (b) The qualifications required for a person to become a coach of a spirit
30 squad.

31 3. If the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association intends to adopt, repeal
32 or amend a policy, rule or regulation concerning or affecting homeschooled
33 children, the Association shall consult with the Northern Nevada Homeschool
34 Advisory Council and the Southern Nevada Homeschool Advisory Council, or their
35 successor organizations, to provide those Councils with a reasonable opportunity to
36 submit data, opinions or arguments, orally or in writing, concerning the proposal or
37 change. The Association shall consider all written and oral submissions respecting
38 the proposal or change before taking final action.

39 4. As used in this section, "spirit squad" means any team or other group of
40 persons that is formed for the purpose of:

41 (a) Leading cheers or rallies to encourage support for a team that participates in
42 a sport that is sanctioned by the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association; or

43 (b) Participating in a competition against another team or other group of
44 persons to determine the ability of each team or group of persons to engage in an
45 activity specified in paragraph (a).

46 **Sec. 3.** The Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association shall, on or before
47 June 30, 2014, amend its rules and regulations, including, without limitation, NAC
48 386.693, as necessary to conform to the provisions of section 1 of this act.

1 Sec. 3.5. Notwithstanding the amendatory provisions of this act, the
2 Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association may, before the effective date of
3 the regulations required by section 3 of this act or July 1, 2014, whichever is
4 earlier, approve:

5 1. The staging of an all-star game, contest or meet by any other
6 organization; and

7 2. The participation of an all-star team in a game, contest or meet
8 regardless of whether the game, contest or meet is approved by any other
9 organization.

10 Sec. 4. 1. This section and section 3.5 of this act ~~becomes~~ become
11 effective.

13 2. Sections 1, 2 and 3 of this act become effective:

14 (a) Upon passage and approval for the purpose of adopting regulations; and
