AN ACT relating to public works; requiring the Administrator of the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration to authorize the construction or installation of a memorial dedicated to Nevada's fallen soldiers on the Capitol Complex; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1        This bill requires the Administrator of the State Public Works Division of the Department  
2        of Administration to authorize the construction or installation of a memorial dedicated to  
3        Nevada's fallen soldiers on the Capitol Complex. This bill requires ~~Gold Star Families of~~  
4        ~~Nevada National, Inc.,~~ the American Legion Department of Nevada, or its successor  
5        organization, to submit a design for the memorial to the Administrator for his or her  
6        approval. This bill also requires the ~~Office of Veterans Services~~ Nevada Veterans Services  
7        Commission to determine the criteria for the placing of names on the memorial and  
8        authorizes the Administrator to accept any gift, grant or donation from any source for the  
9        maintenance of the memorial. Finally, this bill prohibits the use of any public money for the  
10      design, construction or installation of the memorial.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1        **Section 1.** 1. The Administrator of the State Public Works Division of the Department  
2        of Administration shall, upon compliance with the provisions of this  
3        section, allow ~~Gold Star Families of Nevada National, Inc.,~~ the American Legion

1       **Department of Nevada, or its successor organization**, to construct or install a  
2       memorial dedicated to Nevada's fallen soldiers. The memorial must be constructed  
3       or installed at an appropriate location on the Capitol Complex as determined by the  
4       Administrator.

5       2. ~~Gold Star Families of Nevada National, Inc.,~~ **The American Legion**  
6       **Department of Nevada, or its successor organization**, shall submit to the  
7       Administrator a design for the memorial for approval by the Administrator. Upon  
8       approval of the design, the construction or installation of the memorial may begin.

9       3. The ~~Office of Veterans Services~~ **Nevada Veterans Services**  
10      **Commission** shall determine the criteria for the placing of names of Nevada's  
11      fallen soldiers on the memorial.

12      4. The Administrator may accept any gift, grant or donation from any source.  
13      Any money received pursuant to this subsection must be accounted for separately  
14      and used only for the maintenance of the memorial.

15      5. No public money may be spent for the design, construction or installation  
16      of the memorial.

17      Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
