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AN ACT relating to public works; requiring the Administrator of the State Public Works Division of the Department of Administration to authorize the construction or installation of a memorial dedicated to Nevada's fallen soldiers on the Capitol Complex; creating the Nevada Fallen Soldier Memorial Gift Account in the State General Fund; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

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**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 This bill requires the Administrator of the State Public Works Division of the Department  
2 of Administration to authorize the construction or installation of a memorial dedicated to  
3 Nevada's fallen soldiers on the Capitol Complex. ~~This~~ Section 1 of this bill requires the  
4 American Legion Department of Nevada, or its successor organization, to :(1) establish a  
5 committee to design the memorial; and (2) submit a design for the memorial to the Administrator  
6 and the Nevada Veterans Services Commission for ~~his or her~~ their approval. ~~This bill~~ Section 1 also requires the ~~Nevada Veterans Services~~ Commission to  
7 determine the criteria for the placing of names on the memorial. ~~and~~ Section 1.5 of this  
8 bill: (1) creates the Nevada Fallen Soldier Memorial Gift Account in the State General  
9 Fund; (2) authorizes the ~~Administrator~~ Executive Director and the Deputy Executive  
10 Director for Veterans Services to accept any gift, grant or donation from any source for  
11 deposit with the State Treasurer for credit to the Account; and (3) authorizes money in  
12 the Account to be used for the design, construction or installation and maintenance of the  
13 memorial. ~~Finally, this bill prohibits the use of any public money for the design, construction~~  
14 ~~or installation of the memorial.~~

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** 1. The Administrator of the State Public Works Division of the  
2 Department of Administration shall, upon compliance with the provisions of this  
3 section, allow the American Legion Department of Nevada, or its successor  
4 organization, to construct or install a memorial dedicated to Nevada's fallen  
5 soldiers. The memorial must be constructed or installed at an appropriate location  
6 on the Capitol Complex as determined by the Administrator.

7       2. The American Legion Department of Nevada, or its successor organization,  
8 shall ~~submit~~ :

9             (a) In consultation with such volunteers as it deems desirable and the  
10 Nevada Veterans Services Commission, establish a committee to design the  
11 memorial; and

12             (b) Submit to the Administrator and the Commission a design for the  
13 memorial for approval by the Administrator. ~~and the Commission.~~

14             Upon approval of the design, the construction or installation of the memorial may  
15 begin.

16       3. The Nevada Veterans Services Commission shall determine the criteria for  
17 the placing of names of Nevada's fallen soldiers on the memorial.

18       4. ~~The Administrator may accept any gift, grant or donation from any source.~~  
19 ~~Any money received pursuant to this subsection must be accounted for separately~~  
20 ~~and used only for the maintenance of the memorial.~~

21       5. ~~No public money may be spent for the design, construction or installation~~  
22 ~~of the memorial.~~ As used in this section, "fallen soldier" means a person who  
23 dies as a result of an injury sustained while on active duty whether or not the  
24 person had been discharged from military service at the time of his or her  
25 death.

26       **Sec. 1.5.** 1. The Nevada Fallen Soldier Memorial Gift Account is  
27 hereby created in the State General Fund. The Executive Director for  
28 Veterans Services and the Deputy Executive Director for Veterans Services  
29 may accept donations, gifts and grants of money from any source for deposit  
30 with the State Treasurer for credit to the Account.

31       2. The Executive Director for Veterans Services shall administer the  
32 Account.

33       3. The money in the Account may only be used for the design,  
34 construction or installation and maintenance of the memorial described in  
35 section 1 of this act.

36       4. The interest and any other income earned on the money in the  
37 Account, after deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to the  
38 Account.

39       5. Claims against the Account must be paid as other claims against the  
40 State are paid.

41       6. Any money remaining in the Account at the end of each fiscal year  
42 does not revert to the State General Fund, but must be carried over to the next  
43 fiscal year.

44       Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
