AN ACT relating to campaign practices; amending the definition of “committee for political action” to include certain organizations and entities that receive contributions or make expenditures in excess of certain amounts for the purpose of affecting an election; requiring such organizations and entities to register as committees for political action; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 Section 1 of this bill revises the definition of “committee for political action” to include
2 any business or social organization, corporation, partnership, association, trust, unincorporated
3 organization or labor union that: (1) has as its major **primary** purpose affecting the outcome
4 of an election and for that purpose receives in excess of \$1,500 in contributions or makes
5 expenditures in excess of \$1,500 in a calendar year; or (2) does not have as its major
6 **primary** purpose affecting the outcome of an election but for that purpose receives in excess
7 of \$5,000 in contributions or makes expenditures in excess of \$5,000 in a calendar year.
8 Section 2 of this bill requires all such organizations and entities to register with the Secretary
9 of State not later than 7 **calendar** days after qualifying as a committee for political action.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 294A.0055 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 294A.0055 1. “Committee for political action” means ~~any~~ :
3 (a) **Any** group of natural persons or entities that solicits or receives
4 contributions from any other person, group or entity and:
5 ~~(a)~~ (1) Makes or intends to make contributions to candidates or other
6 persons; or
7 ~~(b)~~ (2) Makes or intends to make expenditures,
8 → designed to affect the outcome of any primary election, primary city election,
9 general election, general city election, special election or question on the ballot.
10 (b) **Any business or social organization, corporation, partnership,**
11 **association, trust, unincorporated organization or labor union:**

1 (1) Which has as its ~~major~~ primary purpose affecting the outcome of
2 any primary election, primary city election, general election, general city election,
3 special election or any question on the ballot and for that purpose receives
4 contributions in excess of \$1,500 in a calendar year or makes expenditures in
5 excess of \$1,500 in a calendar year; or

6 (2) Which does not have as its ~~major~~ primary purpose affecting the
7 outcome of any primary election, primary city election, general election, general
8 city election, special election or any question on the ballot, but for the purpose of
9 affecting the outcome of any election or question on the ballot receives
10 contributions in excess of \$5,000 in a calendar year or makes ~~an expenditure~~
11 expenditures in excess of \$5,000 in a calendar year.

12 2. "Committee for political action" does not include:

13 (a) An organization made up of legislative members of a political party whose
14 primary purpose is to provide support for their political efforts.

15 (b) An entity solely because it provides goods or services to a candidate or
16 committee in the regular course of its business at the same price that would be
17 provided to the general public.

18 (c) An individual natural person.

19 (d) ~~An~~ Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (b) of subsection 1, an
20 individual corporation or other business organization who has filed articles of
21 incorporation or other documentation of organization with the Secretary of State
22 pursuant to title 7 of NRS.

23 (e) ~~An~~ Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (b) of subsection 1, a labor
24 union.

25 (f) A personal campaign committee or the personal representative of a
26 candidate who receives contributions or makes expenditures that are reported as
27 campaign contributions or expenditures by the candidate.

28 (g) A committee for the recall of a public officer.

29 Sec. 2. NRS 294A.230 is hereby amended to read as follows:

30 294A.230 1. ~~Each~~ Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, each
31 committee for political action shall, before it engages in any activity in this State,
32 register with the Secretary of State on forms supplied by the Secretary of State.

33 2. A person who qualifies as a committee for political action in accordance
34 with:

35 (a) Subparagraph (1) of paragraph (b) of subsection 1 of NRS 294A.0055 by
36 receiving contributions in excess of \$1,500 in a calendar year or making
37 expenditures in excess of \$1,500 in a calendar year; or

38 (b) Subparagraph (2) of paragraph (b) of subsection 1 of NRS 294A.0055 by
39 receiving contributions in excess of \$5,000 in a calendar year or making ~~an~~
40 expenditures in excess of \$5,000 in a calendar year,

41 shall, not later than 7 calendar days after the qualifying event, register with
42 the Secretary of State on forms supplied by the Secretary of State.

43 3. The form must require:

44 (a) The name of the committee ~~for political action~~;

45 (b) The purpose for which it was organized;

46 (c) The names, addresses and telephone numbers of its officers;

47 (d) If the committee for political action is affiliated with any other
48 organizations, the name, address and telephone number of each organization;

49 (e) The name, address and telephone number of its registered agent; and

50 (f) Any other information deemed necessary by the Secretary of State.

51 ~~3.~~ 4. A committee for political action shall file with the Secretary of State:

52 (a) An amended form for registration within 30 days after any change in the
53 information contained in the form for registration.

1 (b) A form for registration on or before January 15 of each year, regardless of
2 whether there is a change in the information contained in the most recent form for
3 registration filed by the committee for political action with the Secretary of State.

5 website the information required pursuant to subsection ~~12~~.

7 6. For purposes of the civil penalty that the Secretary of State may impose
8 pursuant to NRS 294A.420 for violating the provisions of subsection 1 ~~1~~ or 2, if a
9 committee for political action fails to register with the Secretary of State pursuant
10 to subsection 1 ~~1~~ or 2, each time the committee for political action engages in any
11 activity in this State constitutes a separate violation of subsection 1 or 2 for which
12 the Secretary of State may impose a civil penalty.
