AN ACT relating to parentage; providing that the right of a parent to make decisions regarding the ~~upbringing, education and~~ care, custody and management of his or her child is a fundamental right; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 This bill provides that the ~~right~~ liberty interest of a parent ~~to direct~~ in the
 2 ~~upbringing, education and~~ care, custody and management of his or her child is a
 3 fundamental right. ~~Under this bill, in implementing a statute, local ordinance or regulation,~~
 4 ~~the State or any agency, instrumentality or political subdivision of the State is prohibited from~~
 5 ~~violating this right without demonstrating a compelling governmental interest that as applied~~
 6 ~~to the child involved is of the highest order.~~ This bill also provides that this fundamental
 7 right does not: (1) authorize a parent to engage in unlawful conduct or to abuse or
 8 neglect a child; or (2) prohibit courts, law enforcement officers or agencies which
 9 provide child welfare services from acting within their official capacity.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 126 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new
 2 section to read as follows:

3 1. The liberty interest of a parent ~~to direct the upbringing, education and~~
 4 in the care, custody and management of the parent’s child is a fundamental
 5 right. ~~The State of Nevada or any agency, instrumentality or political subdivision~~
 6 of the State shall not violate this right without demonstrating a compelling
 7 governmental interest that as applied to the child involved is of the highest order.

8 2. Nothing in this section shall be construed to:
 9 (a) Authorize a parent to engage in any unlawful conduct or to abuse or
 10 neglect a child in violation of the laws of this State.

1 (b) Prohibit courts, law enforcement officers or employees of an agency
2 which provides child welfare services from acting in their official capacity within
3 the scope of their authority.

4 3. Except as otherwise provided by specific statute, the provisions of this
5 section apply to any statute, local ordinance or regulation and the
6 implementation of such statute, local ordinance or regulation regardless of
7 whether such statute, local ordinance or regulation was adopted or effective
8 before, on or after October 1, 2013.

9 4. As used in this section, "agency which provides child welfare services"
10 has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 432B.030.
