SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the education of certain children who are ~~placed in child care institutions;~~ **patients or residents of certain hospitals or facilities.** (BDR 34-933)

AN ACT relating to education; authorizing certain ~~child care institutions;~~ **hospitals and facilities** to request reimbursement **, under certain circumstances,** for providing educational services to children in their care; authorizing the Department of Education, the county school districts **, charter schools** and the Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services to enter into a cooperative agreement for the provision of ~~education;~~ **educational services** to children ~~placed in certain child care institutions;~~ **at certain hospitals and facilities;** and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

1 **Section 1** of this bill authorizes ~~a child care institution;~~ **certain hospitals or other**  
2 **facilities that are licensed by the Health Division of the Department of Health and**  
3 **Human Services and** that ~~operates an elementary or secondary educational institution;~~  
4 **operate a licensed private school** to request reimbursement **, under certain circumstances,**  
5 from the Department of Education for the cost of providing educational services to a child  
6 who attends the ~~elementary or secondary educational institution;~~ **licensed private school.**  
7 **Section 2** of this bill authorizes the Department of Education, the county school districts **,**  
8 **charter schools** and the Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services to  
9 enter into a cooperative agreement for the provision of ~~education;~~ **educational services** at  
10 ~~any child care institution;~~ **certain hospitals or other facilities** that ~~are~~ **are** licensed by the  
11 Health Division.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** Chapter 387 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new  
2 section to read as follows:

3       1. ~~A child care institution~~ hospital or other facility which is licensed by the  
4 Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services that provides  
5 residential treatment to children and which operates ~~an elementary or secondary~~  
6 educational institution a private school licensed pursuant to chapter 394 of NRS  
7 may request reimbursement from the Department for the cost of providing  
8 educational services to a child who ~~attends the elementary or secondary~~  
9 educational institution.;

10       (a) The Department verifies is a patient or resident of the hospital or facility;  
11 and

12       (b) Attends the private school for more than 7 school days.

13       2. Upon receiving a request for reimbursement, the Department shall  
14 determine the amount of reimbursement to which the ~~child care institution~~  
15 hospital or facility is entitled as a percentage of the basic support guarantee per  
16 pupil and ~~request~~ withhold that amount from the county school district or  
17 charter school where the child would attend school if the child were not placed in  
18 ~~in a child care institution~~ the hospital or facility. The Department shall distribute  
19 the money withheld from the county school district or charter school to the  
20 hospital or facility.

21       3. The Department shall adopt any regulations necessary to carry out the  
22 provisions of this section.

23       4. As used in this section:

24       (a) ~~“Child care institution”~~ “Hospital” has the meaning ascribed to it in  
25 NRS ~~432A.0245.~~ 449.012.

26       (b) ~~“Elementary or secondary educational institution”~~ includes an  
27 academic, vocational, technical, correspondence, business or other school or  
28 other person offering educational credentials, diplomas or certificates, or  
29 offering instruction or educational services. This term includes an institution  
30 providing instruction to pupils in any grade levels from kindergarten through  
31 grade 12. “Private school” has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 394.103.

32       **Sec. 2.** Chapter 277 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new  
33 section to read as follows:

34       1. The Department of Education, the county school districts of the various  
35 counties, charter schools and the Health Division of the Department of Health  
36 and Human Services may enter into cooperative agreements for the provision of  
37 ~~education~~ educational services at any ~~child care institution that~~ hospital or  
38 other facility which is licensed by the Health Division ~~and operated pursuant to~~  
39 chapter 432A of NRS. that provides residential treatment to children and which  
40 operates a private school licensed pursuant to chapter 394 of NRS.

41       2. The authorization provided by subsection 1 includes the right to pay over  
42 money appropriated to a county school district or charter school for the education  
43 of a child placed in ~~in a child care institution~~ such a hospital or facility.

44       3. As used in this section, ~~“child care institution”~~ “hospital” has the  
45 meaning ascribed to it in NRS ~~432A.0245.~~ 449.012.

46       **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective:

47       1. Upon passage and approval for the purposes of entering into cooperative  
48 agreements pursuant to section 2 of this act, adopting regulations and performing

- 1 any other preparatory administrative tasks that are necessary to carry out the
- 2 provisions of this act; and

  2. On July 1, 2013, for all other purposes.
