AN ACT relating to resources; creating the Nevada State Parks and Cultural Resources Endowment Fund; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

1 **Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

2 This bill creates the Nevada State Parks and Cultural Resources Endowment Fund,
3 ~~money,~~ **the income** from which is only to be used for the purposes of enhancing state parks
4 and preserving the cultural resources of this State.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 235 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto a new
2 section to read as follows:

3 1. ***The Nevada State Parks and Cultural Resources Endowment Fund is***
4 ***hereby created as a trust fund in the State Treasury.***

5 2. ***The State Treasurer shall deposit in the Fund any money the State***
6 ***Treasurer receives from any person who wishes to contribute to the Fund.***

7 3. ***The Fund must be administered by a committee consisting of:***

8 (a) ***The Administrator of the Division of State Parks of the State Department***
9 ***of Conservation and Natural Resources;***

10 (b) ***The Administrator of the Office of Historic Preservation of the State***
11 ***Department of Conservation and Natural Resources; and***

12 (c) ***Three members appointed by the Governor.***

13 4. ***The Fund must only be used for the purposes of the enhancement of state***
14 ***parks and the preservation of the cultural resources of this State. Any interest***
15 ***earned on money in the Fund must be credited to the Fund. The money which***
16 ***represents the principal of the Fund must not be spent, and only the interest***
17 ***earned on the principal may be used to carry out the provisions of this section.***

1 *5. As used in this section, “cultural resources” has the meaning ascribed to
2 it in subsection 3 of NRS 383.011.*

3 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
