AN ACT relating to cultural resources; creating the Nevada State Parks and Cultural Resources Endowment Fund; designating the Picon Punch as the official state drink; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

~~[This bill]~~ Section 1.5 of this bill creates the Nevada State Parks and Cultural Resources Endowment Fund, the income from which is only to be used for the purposes of enhancing state parks and preserving the cultural resources of this State.

Section 1.7 of this bill designates the traditional Basque drink known as the Picon Punch as the official state drink of the State of Nevada.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 235 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto ~~[a new section to read as follows:]~~ the provisions set forth as sections 1.5 and 1.7 of this act.

Sec. 1.5. 1. The Nevada State Parks and Cultural Resources Endowment Fund is hereby created as a trust fund in the State Treasury.

2. The State Treasurer shall deposit in the Fund any money the State Treasurer receives from any person who wishes to contribute to the Fund.

3. The Fund must be administered by a committee consisting of:

(a) The Administrator of the Division of State Parks of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources;

(b) The Administrator of the Office of Historic Preservation of the State Department of Conservation and Natural Resources; and

1 (c) Three members appointed by the Governor ~~with~~ with a view toward
2 balancing gender and ethnicity.

3 4. Insofar as practicable, the appointed members of the committee must
4 reflect the geographical diversity of this State, and at least one of those members
5 must have experience in the field of financial management or trust management.
6 After the initial terms, each such member serves a term of 4 years. A member
7 may be reappointed.

8 5. The committee shall, at its first meeting and biennially thereafter, elect a
9 chair from among the appointed members of the committee. The committee shall
10 meet at such times and places as are specified by a call of the chair.

11 6. The Fund must only be used for the purposes of the enhancement of state
12 parks and the preservation of the cultural resources of this State. Any interest
13 earned on money in the Fund must be credited to the Fund. The money which
14 represents the principal of the Fund must not be spent, and only the interest
15 earned on the principal may be used to carry out the provisions of this section.

16 ~~5.7~~ 7. As used in this section, "cultural resources" has the meaning
17 ascribed to it in subsection 3 of NRS 383.011.

18 Sec. 1.7. The traditional Basque drink known as the Picon Punch is hereby
19 designated as the official state drink of the State of Nevada.

20 Sec. 1.9. As soon as practicable after the effective date of this act, the
21 Governor shall appoint to the committee created by section 1.5 of this act the
22 appointed members of that committee. The members appointed initially to the
23 committee pursuant to this section shall determine by lot whether they are
24 designated to serve a term of 2, 3 or 4 years, respectively.

25 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
