SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION—Expressing support for wild horses and burros in Nevada.

1 WHEREAS, Wild horses and burros are an integral part of the ecosystem and
2 rangelands of the United States and the State of Nevada; and

3 WHEREAS, Wild horses and burros helped to build this nation and are living
4 symbols of freedom and our American Western heritage, as represented by the
5 depiction of wild horses on the Nevada State quarter; and

6 WHEREAS, Wild horses and burros are natural resources and cultural assets, and
7 have the potential to promote tourism and job creation in this State; and

8 WHEREAS, Building eco-sanctuaries that enable the public to view and
9 photograph wild horses and burros may provide a much needed boost to the Nevada
10 economy; and

11 ~~WHEREAS, The Bureau of Land Management is required to maintain a thriving
12 natural ecological balance and multiple use relationship on public lands in the State
13 of Nevada; and~~

14 ~~WHEREAS, Limiting the numbers of wild horses and burros on public and
15 private lands may jeopardize their genetic diversity, health and long term survival
16 in the State of Nevada; and~~

17 WHEREAS, ~~Healthy rangelands and healthy wild~~ **Wild** horses and burros
18 depend on the understanding, cooperation and fairness of all interested parties;
19 now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, JOINTLY,
21 That the Nevada Legislature:

22 1. Supports the preservation and protection of our iconic wild horses and
23 burros ~~on public and private lands~~ in the State of Nevada as living symbols of
24 freedom, the pioneer spirit of the West and America's heritage, as well as valuable
25 natural resources and cultural assets;

26 2. Supports the development of wild horse and burro related ecotourism in the
27 State of Nevada;

28 3. Encourages the State Department of Agriculture to enter into cooperative
29 agreements with local wild horse and burro advocacy groups pursuant to

1 NRS 569.031 concerning wild horses and burros living on private lands that are
2 under the jurisdiction of the State Department of Agriculture; and

3 4. Encourages a spirit of cooperation, collaboration and fairness among wild
4 horse and burro advocacy groups, private land owners,~~H and~~ the State Department
5 of Agriculture ~~; I, the Bureau of Land Management and the United States Forest~~
6 ~~Service;~~ and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate prepare and transmit a copy of this
8 resolution to the Vice President of the United States as the presiding officer of the
9 United States Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, each member of
10 the Nevada Congressional Delegation, the ~~Secretary of the Interior, the Secretary~~
11 ~~of Agriculture, the Director of the Bureau of Land Management, the Chief of the~~
12 ~~United States Forest Service~~ ~~Governor~~ and the Director of the State Department
