

SENATE BILL NO. 102—SENATOR KIECKHEFER

FEBRUARY 11, 2013

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to the Kenny C. Guinn Memorial Millennium Scholarship. (BDR 34-837)

AN ACT relating to education; expanding the scope of the Kenny C. Guinn Memorial Millennium Scholarship by requiring the Board of Trustees of the College Savings Plans of Nevada to award the Memorial Scholarship to two eligible recipients each year; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law requires the Board of Trustees of the College Savings Plans of
2 Nevada to award annually the Kenny C. Guinn Memorial Millennium Scholarship
3 to one eligible recipient who is a senior or rising senior at a university, state college
4 or community college within the Nevada System of Higher Education or at certain
5 other accredited colleges or universities in this State. (NRS 396.945) This bill
6 requires the Board to award annually the Memorial Scholarship to one eligible
7 recipient who is a student enrolled at the University of Nevada, Reno, Great Basin
8 College or Sierra Nevada College and to one eligible recipient who is a student
9 enrolled at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, or Nevada State College.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 396.945 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 396.945 1. ***The Board shall annually award the Memorial***
3 ***Scholarship to:***
4 (a) ***One recipient who is a student enrolled at the University of***
5 ***Nevada, Reno, Great Basin College or Sierra Nevada College; and***
6 (b) ***One recipient who is a student enrolled at the University of***
7 ***Nevada, Las Vegas, or Nevada State College.***



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1 2. The Board shall establish **additional** criteria governing the
2 annual selection of ~~the~~ **each** recipient of the Memorial
3 Scholarship, which must include, without limitation, a requirement
4 that ~~the~~ **a** recipient:

- 5 (a) Be in or entering his or her senior year at an ~~eligible~~
6 **academic** institution ~~the~~ **described in subsection 1;**
7 (b) Be on the list of eligible students for a Millennium
8 Scholarship which is certified to the State Treasurer pursuant to
9 NRS 396.934;
10 (c) Have a college grade point average of not less than 3.5 on a
11 4.0 grading scale;
12 (d) Have a declared major in elementary education or secondary
13 education;
14 (e) Have a stated commitment to teaching in this State following
15 graduation; and
16 (f) Have a commendable record of community service.

17 ~~2.~~ 3. A student who satisfies the criteria established pursuant
18 to ~~subsection~~ **this section** may apply for a Memorial Scholarship
19 by submitting an application to the Office of the State Treasurer on
20 a form provided on the Internet website of the State Treasurer.

21 ~~3.~~ 4. The State Treasurer shall forward all applications
22 received pursuant to subsection ~~2.~~ 3 to the Board. The Board shall
23 review and evaluate each application received from the State
24 Treasurer and select ~~the~~ **each** recipient of the Memorial
25 Scholarship ~~the~~.

26 ~~4.~~ **in accordance with the criteria established pursuant to this
27 section.**

28 5. To the extent of available money in the account established
29 pursuant to NRS 396.940, the annual Memorial Scholarship may be
30 awarded to ~~the~~ **each** selected recipient in an amount not to exceed
31 \$4,500 to pay the educational expenses of the recipient for the
32 school year which are authorized by subsection ~~5.~~ 6 and which are
33 not otherwise paid for by the Millennium Scholarship awarded to
34 the recipient.

35 ~~5.~~ 6. A Memorial Scholarship must be used only:
36 (a) For the payment of registration fees and laboratory fees and
37 expenses;

38 (b) To purchase required textbooks and course materials; and
39 (c) For other costs related to the attendance of the student at the

40 ~~eligible~~ **academic** institution ~~the~~
41 **in which he or she is enrolled.**



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1 **7.** As used in this section, “Board” means the Board of
2 Trustees of the College Savings Plans of Nevada created by
3 NRS 353B.005.

4 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.

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
